MATCH NOTES

• Seattle Sounders FC hosts St. Louis CITY SC on Saturday, May 3 on the Emerald Queen Casino Pitch at Lumen Field (7:30 p.m. PT / Apple TV, 93.3 KJR FM, El Rey 1360 AM).

• The Rave Green are coming off a 1-1 draw with the Colorado Rapids on April 26. Danny Musovski scored for Seattle, his third consecutive match recording a strike, the longest streak of his MLS career.

• With the result, Sounders FC currently sit in ninth place in the Western Conference with 13 points. St. Louis is in 12th place in the West with 10 points.

• Seattle and St. Louis have met five times in MLS play with the Rave Green holding a 4-1-0 record, falling to the Midwestern side for the first time earlier this year 1-0 at Energizer Park.

• Sounders FC goalkeeper Stefan Frei is looking to record his 400th all-competition appearance for the club, becoming one of seven players to reach that milestone with one team.

• St. Louis has scored an own goal against Seattle in four of the five matches between the two sides, three shy of the MLS record for most own goals against a single opponent (D.C. United vs. Columbus).

• Head Coach Brian Schmetzer has recorded 129 regular-season win in his career since taking over the club in 2016 and is now one win shy of entering the top 10 of all coaches in MLS history.

• Tacoma Defiance forward Osaze De Rosario is available for selection in Saturday's match via Short-Term Agreement.

• Following Saturday's matchup, Seattle begins a three-match road stretch against Houston Dynamo FC on Saturday, May 10, LAFC on Wednesday, May 14 and the Portland Timbers on Saturday, May 17.

Seattle suffered its first-ever loss to St. Louis on March 15, falling 1-0 at Energizer Park. A free kick by Eduard Löwen in the 15th minute proved to be the difference in the contest, with Seattle's rotated lineup unable to find the equalizing goal.

The trip to St. Louis marked the third match in a week for the Rave Green, defeating LAFC 5-2 on March 8 before falling 4-1 to Liga MX side Cruz Azul in Mexico City on March 11 in 2025 Concacaf Champions Cup play.

Stefan Frei has recorded 399 all-competition appearances for Seattle since joining the team in 2014 and is looking to become one of seven players in MLS history to record 400 all-competition appearances with one club. He is the only player in soccer history to win a MLS Cup, Supporters' Shield, Concacaf Champions Cup, U.S. Open Cup and Canadian Championship.

TACOMA DEFIANCE UPDATE



Tacoma Defiance, Seattle's MLS NEXT Pro affiliate, recorded two 4-1 victories last week over Sporting KC II and St. Louis CITY2, respectively. Osaze De Rosario scored three goals over the two matches, giving him eight goals in five league games, most in MLS NEXT Pro. With the results, Defiance moved into second place in the Pacific Division. The club now faces Pacific Division-leading Ventura County FC on Friday, May 2 at William Rolland Stadium (7:00 p.m. PT / Apple TV).

Following the match against Ventura County, Tacoma continues its 2025 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup campaign, taking on the Portland Timbers in the Round of 32 on Tuesday, May 6 at Starfire Stadium (7:00 p.m. PT / Paramount+, CBS Sports Network). Defiance is the last remaining of the eight MLS NEXT Pro teams that entered the tournament, with Portland entering in the Round of 32 as one of 16 MLS teams.

THE MOOSE IS LOOSE



With his goal against Colorado on April 26, Seattle forward Danny Musovski scored in his third consecutive match, also scoring against FC Dallas on April 12 and Nashville SC on April 19.

Musovski became the first player to score in three consecutive MLS matches since Raúl Ruidíaz did so last season from March 9 - March 23. Ruidíaz is also the last Sounder to score in four consecutive matches, doing so from May 26, 2019 - July 21, 2019. Fredy Montero (June 13, 2009 - July 11, 2009) and Obafemi Martins (August 30, 2015 - September 27 2015) hold the record for most consecutive games with a goal in club history with five matches.

SOUNDERS FC AND REIGN FC ANNOUNCE HISTORIC PARTNERSHIP WITH FOX 13 SEATTLE



In a groundbreaking moment for Seattle soccer, Seattle Sounders FC and Seattle Reign FC on May 1 announced a historic multi-year partnership with FOX 13 Seattle, creating a unified broadcast platform for both clubs for the first time in the region's storied soccer history.

This landmark collaboration, designating FOX 13 Seattle as the Official Flagship Local Broadcast Partner of both Sounders FC and Reign FC, underscores the combined strength and growing impact of men's and women's professional soccer. It represents a major step forward in providing fans expansive and inclusive coverage, celebrating Seattle's rich soccer tradition on a shared stage.

Effective immediately, the first Reign FC contest on FOX 13's air kicks off on Friday, May 2 live from Lumen Field, as the home side takes on the Kansas City Current at 7:30 p.m. PT. For Sounders FC, the partnership includes a diverse array of shoulder programming, news and sports coverage, in addition to in-season specials and features throughout the year. Live Sounders FC matches continue to air on MLS Season Pass on Apple TV.

FOX 13 is continuing its strong coverage of Sounders FC and industry-leading reporting throughout the MLS season, and now becomes the official matchday broadcast home of Reign FC. Including onsite talent and production, this marks the first time in club history that Reign FC has integrated, on-location production services for its games. 11 NWSL matches are slated for air this season, with FOX 13's trusted on-air talent and dedicated crews providing blanket coverage, bringing fans closer to their favorite teams throughout the year.

Beyond match broadcasts, FOX 13 and the clubs are investing in expanded programming designed to deepen fan connections and build awareness of the many happenings across the Puget Sound soccer scene.

The new partnership features the following elements for Seattle soccer fans to enjoy.

Featuring cool green and blue tones evoking Pacific Northwestern waters and a unique pattern derived from Coast Salish weaving traditions in collaboration with indigenous artists representing the Puyallup, Muckleshoot and Suquamish Tribes, The Salish Sea Kit serves a call to protect what sustains us and to celebrate the connections that make us whole.

This one-of-a-kind kit also has purpose beyond the pitch. Sounders FC is committed to donating proceeds up to \$50,000 from the first 30 days of The Salish Sea Kit’s sales to organizations dedicated to preserving the cultural heritage of tribal communities and protecting the Salish Sea’s remarkable ecosystem, including: The Burke Museum, Potlatch Fund, Puget Soundkeeper, Seattle Aquarium and RAVE Foundation.

These funds will be thoughtfully invested to support youth education and arts programs honoring the traditions of Washington State’s tribal communities, advance conservation efforts to restore the health of the Salish Sea and provide meaningful experiences for tribal youth, including educational field trips and opportunities to attend Sounders FC matches.

Through these initiatives, Sounders FC aims to honor the interconnectedness of the region’s people and environment, creating a legacy that uplifts communities and inspires stewardship of the Salish Sea.

Born at the water’s edge in 1974, Sounders FC has been inextricably connected to the Puget Sound from the club’s earliest days. But the waters of the Sound – part of the greater Salish Sea – have a history far deeper and vaster, stretching back through the generations to time immemorial. The Salish Sea flows both literally through its waters and figuratively through its spirit, sustaining life and building strong communities. Sounders FC’s Salish Sea Kit honors water as a life force and a vessel for rich cultural traditions.

The jersey’s striking geometric pattern suggests a sense of dimensionality and flow, inspired by twilling and twining, two traditional Southern Coast Salish weaving techniques. These techniques, passed down through generations, pay respect to the resilience, connection and creativity that define the cultural fabric of the region.

The design draws directly from the artistry of three distinguished indigenous Pacific Northwestern artists Connie McCloud, Gail White Eagle and Danielle Morsette.

Coast Salish artist Louie Gong (Nooksack Tribe) played an instrumental role in bringing this group of collaborators together, recommending that the jersey’s story be told through the work of these three talented women who have now brought their weaving traditions to life on a global stage, constructing The Salish Sea Kit as an authentic and novel testament to Coast Salish tradition.


The phrase “Water Is Sacred” appears on the bottom left corner of each jersey front, proudly printed in both English and Southern Lushootseed, the traditional language of the Puyallup, Muckleshoot, Suquamish and neighboring Coast Salish tribes. This powerful statement underscores the deep cultural and spiritual connection to the Salish Sea and serves as a reminder of the shared responsibility to protect it.

The neck hit features an original design that combines a wave of water, the tail of an orca and a flowing “S” that represents both the Seattle Sounders and the Salish Sea. Anchored by the club’s birth year, 1974, this motif reflects a commitment to stewardship that spans generations – connecting the past, present and future in the fight to preserve our environment.

The right jersey sleeve showcases the logo of the Puyallup Tribe, an original steward of the land throughout what is now known as the Puget Sound. The tribe and its Emerald Queen Casino have partnered with Sounders FC since 2021.

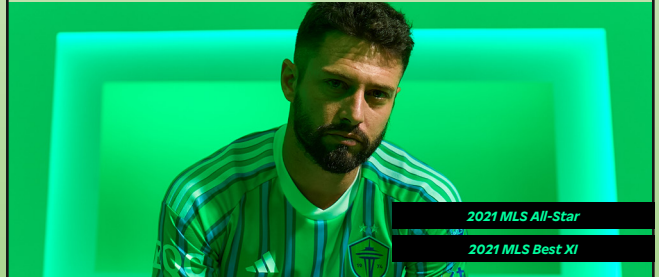

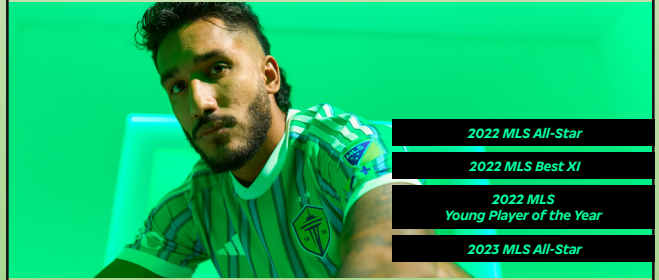

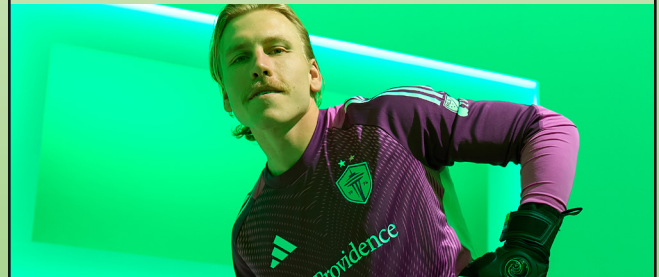
