# Inter Miami in 2025 MLS Regular Season

Inter Miami is currently eigth in the Eastern Conference standings with 46 points and a record of 13 wins, six losses and seven draws.

# **Firing Attack**

Inter Miami's attacking unit has been in fine form so far this 2025 regular season, with forwards/wingers/attacking midfielders accounting for 44 of the team's 54 goals thus far this MLS regular season.

Messi leads the way with 19 goals and is currently in second place in the race for the Golden Boot presented by Audi. Tadeo Allende and Telasco Segovia come next with seven goals each, while Luis Suárez follows with six goals. Fafa Picault and Allen Obando round out the list with four goals and a strike respectively.

# **Previously Against Seattle Sounders FC**

Tuesday's encounter will be the third between the sides in Club history. The series is even to date, with Inter Miami and Seattle Sounders claiming a win each in the past meetings.

# **Scouting Seattle Sounders FC**

Seattle Sounders visit Inter Miami after drawing 2-2 at home against the LA Galaxy in their most recent regular season game. In all, the Sounders have recorded 12 wins, seven losses and nine draws for a total 45 points and currentlt sit fourth in the Western Conference standings.

Forward Danny Musovski leads the team in goals with 14 this regular season, while the top assist providers are midfielder Albert Rusnák and attacker Paul Rothrock with seven a piece.

In addition to the MLS team, the Club fields MLS NEXT Pro team Inter Miami CF II and has a youth Academy for ages U-12 to U-19. Inter Miami CF Main Partners include: Royal Caribbean, Fracht Group, JPMorgan Chase, Baptist Health, Florida Blue, and Polkadot.

The highly-anticipated 2025 season will see the Club compete in Major League Soccer (MLS), the FIFA Club World Cup, Concacaf Champions Cup and Leagues Cup following a historic 2024 campaign that saw the Club claim the Supporters' Shield and set the MLS record for most regular season points. f

# The Fortitude Jersey: 2025 Away Jersey

Inter Miami CF unveiled the Fortitude Jersey this past December, the Club's bold new adidas away jersey for the highly-anticipated 2025 season. The name of the Club's new away jersey, Fortitude, comes from the Latin word "Fortis," which means strength, and the Spanish word "Fortaleza," which stands for resilience and determination. The name Euforia captures the excitement and anticipation of what is next for Inter Miami CF. From competing at an unprecedented international level in 2025 to moving into a new, state-of-the-art stadium in Miami in 2026, this is more than just a change of scenery; it's the beginning of a thrilling new era for the Club. Euforia embodies the passion and energy of embracing these opportunities head on, knowing that Inter Miami is ready to step onto the pitch with the best and keep dreaming big.

### 2024 Success

The 2024 MLS regular season was the best one yet for the Club. Inter Miami achieved a record-breaking campaign in which the Club recorded historic stats, orchestrating an impressive turnaround for the team, going from 27th in the Supporters' Shield race in 2023 to first in 2024.

The notable achievements for the side that was managed by head coach Gerardo 'Tata' Martino include setting a new single-season points record in the league with 74 points, registering the best overall 2024 MLS regular season record (22W-4L-8D) to win the Supporters' Shield and clinch a second title in Club history, becoming the third-fastest club in league history to earn a playoffs berth and secure a third-ever postseason appearance for the Club, recording the most overall wins (22) and wins on the road (11), and leading the league in goals with 83.



# 2025 MLS Player of the Matchday Honorees:

**Matchday 16:** Forward Lionel Messi: The reigning Landon Donovan MVP scored a brace with two fantastic-strikes and dished out an assist to lead Inter Miami to a 4-2 win at home over CF Montréal on Wednesday. The attacker delivered an all-around top performance, finishing the night with a notable three key passes and seven shots to his name, both game highs. The recognition is Messi's first Player of the Matchday award and the first for an Inter Miami player this 2025 regular season. Last year, Messi earned a record-tying six Player of the Matchday awards, becoming the third player in league history to do so during his first full season with Inter Miami.

**Matchday 17:** Forward Lionel Messi: Messi earned POTM honors for a second consecutive matchday following his brilliance on the pitch, notching two goals and three assists in a dominant 5-1 home win for Inter Miami over Columbus. Overall it was a well rounded performance from Messi as he led the Herons to victory, registering an 87 percent pass completion rate and two shots on target. Messi became the first player to win back-to-back Player of the Matchday awards this season and second to win twice in 2025, joining Philadelphia Union forward Tai Baribo.

**Matchday 22:** Forward Lionel Messi: Messi earned POTM honors after leading the dominant 1-4 road victory for Inter Miami over CF Montréal on Saturday was Messi, tallying two goals and an assist. The 2024 Landon Donovan MLS MVP has now recorded at least two goals and one assist in three consecutive league matches, becoming the fourth player in MLS history to accomplish the feat and the first since Thierry Henry in 2012. Messi has recorded nine games with at least three goal contributions since entering the league on August 26, 2023, two more than the next-closest player over the span (Denis Bouanga, seven). The honor is Messi's third this season and ninth MLS Player of the Matchday award in his career.

**Matchdays 23/24:** Forward Lionel Messi: Our Club captain continued a historic hot streak last week, bagging braces to boost Inter Miami to a 1-2 win at New England Revolution on Wednesday night and a 2-1 triumph vs. Nashville SC on Saturday. The pair of two-goal performances marked Messi's fourth and fifth consecutive league games with braces and the Argentine legend has now netted 11 goals over his last six games, tied with forward Josef Martínez for the most-ever across a six-game stretch in league history. He's the first player in MLS history with multiple goals in five-straight games. The honor is Messi's fourth Player of the Matchday award this season and 10th overall.

**Matchday 26:** Forward Lionel Messi: It was his fifth Player of the Matchday presented by Michelob Ultra honor of the season, and his third since Matchday 22. His 11 Player of the Matchday accolades are tied with Chris Wondolowski (11) for the fifth-most in MLS history and trail only Landon Donovan (19), Jeff Cunningham (14), and Bradley Wright-Phillips (12). Messi is the first player in league history to win Player of the Matchday at least five times in a single season twice, after taking home the award six times during his Landon Donvan MLS MVP campaign in 2024.

# 2025 MLS Player of the Month Honorees:

**May:** Forward Lionel Messi: Messi earned Player of the Month honors thanks to his scorching form in May, scoring seven goals and adding four assists to lead the league in goal contributions (11). Inter Miami finished May undefeated in its last three matches, powered by stellar showings from the reigning Landon Donovan MLS MVP.

**July:** Forward Lionel Messi: The legendary Argentine attacker had one of the hottest streaks in MLS history during the month of July, netting eight goals and adding three assists. Fresh off Inter Miami CF's knockout stage appearance at the FIFA Club World Cup, the Club went 4-1-1 this month to push themselves in the thick of the Supporters' Shield race at 42 points (12-4-6) with multiple games in-hand on the seven teams above them.



- Holds several records across different competitions like: the most goals scored in a calendar year (91 goals), most goals in Europe's top five leagues (496 goals), most LaLiga goals (474 goals), most LaLiga goals in a single season (50 goals), most UEFA Champions League group stage goals (80 goals), most UEFA Champions League round of 16 goals (29 goals), and most successive seasons scoring in UEFA Champions League (18).
- At the international level, Messi has made history in Argentina, holding the most caps with 175, the most goals with 103, and the most World Cup match appearances with 26.
