#### **MATCH NOTES**

- $\cdot$  Seattle Sounders FC hosts Austin FC on Saturday, June 28 on the Emerald Queen Casino Pitch at Lumen Field (7:30 p.m. PT / Apple TV, 93.3 KJR FM, El Rey 1360 AM).
- · This weekend's contest marks the return to MLS play for the Rave Green, who just concluded their FIFA Club World Cup 2025™ campaign. The club bowed out in the Group Stage, dropping results to 2024 South American champion Botafogo, Spanish power Atlético Madrid and 2025 UEFA Champions League winner Paris Saint-Germain.
- Seattle was one of three MLS teams participating in the global tournament, alongside LAFC and Inter Miami CF, and was the only team to qualify for the competition by winning the Concacaf Champions Cup.
- Sounders FC and Austin have met eight times since the Texas side joined MLS in 2021, with Seattle playing to a 4-1-3 record, giving up multiple goals on only one occasion. Seattle won the regular-season series last year, 1-0-1.
- In league play, the Rave Green are coming off a 3-0 loss to Vancouver Whitecaps FC on June 8, while Austin defeated the New York Red Bulls 2-1 on June 14 at Q2 Stadium.
- Seattle goalkeeper Stefan Frei is currently sitting at 998 regular-season saves since joining the club prior to the 2014 season. He is looking to become the second goalkeeper in MLS history to record 1,000 saves with one club (Nick Rimando, who made 1,128 saves with Real Salt Lake).
- Sounders FC striker Jordan Morris made his return to the pitch in Seattle's final Group Stage match against PSG. The Mercer Island native has been dealing with a hamstring injury since early March.
- · Following this weekend's match, Seattle stays at home to take on the Columbus Crew in a Sunday Night Soccer matchup on July 6 on the Emerald Queen Casino Pitch at Lumen Field (2:00 p.m. PT / Apple TV, iHeartMedia Seattle, El Rey 1360 AM).

#### **JULY 2021 REWIND: THE TEENAGERS SHINE**



One of the most infamous matches of Seattle's MLS history took place against Austin FC during the Texas side's inaugural season on July 22, 2021. Brian Schmetzer fielded five teenagers – Reed Baker-Whiting, Obed Vargas, Danny Leyva, Ethan Dobbelaere and Josh Atencio – for the road match due to multiple starters being unavailable for selection, the first and only time in league history five teenagers started a competitive match.

After a scoreless first half, Raúl Ruidíaz subbed on and scored a stunning goal from midfield in the 67th minute to secure the 1-0 victory for the Rave Green, keeping them in first place in the Western Conference.

Seattle forward Jordan Morris recorded his 87th all-competition goal against LAFC on March 8, breaking a tie with Raúl Ruidíaz for most in club history. The former Sounders FC Academy player now stands alone at the top of a list of iconic goal scorers for Sounders FC.

# JORDAN MORRIS MAKES HIS RETURN

Sounders FC star striker Jordan Morris returned to the pitch in Seattle's final Group Stage match of the FIFA Club World Cup 2025™ against Paris Saint-Germain, making a substitute appearance in the 87th minute. The Mercer Island native has been out with a hamstring injury, originally picking up the injury against Cruz Azul on March 11 before re-aggrevating it on April 26 against Colorado during a brief appearance.

He recorded his 87th goal in all competitions on March 5 of this year against LAFC, becoming the club's all-time leading goal scorer and surpassing former Seattle striker Raúl Ruidíaz.

Morris originally joined Seattle when he signed a Homegrown contract prior to the 2016 season, going on to win MLS Rookie of the Year behind a 12-goal, four-assist campaign, helping the Rave Green win their first MLS Cup that same season

With 256 all-competition appearances under his belt, Morris has also helped the club win the 2019 MLS Cup and 2022 Concacaf Champions Cup and was named the 2019 MLS Comeback Player of the Year, a member of the 2020 MLS Best XI and an MLS All-Star in 2022 and 2023.



Tacoma Defiance currently sits in sixth place in the Pacific Division with 17 points (5-6-1). The club is coming off a 2-1 loss to Real Monarchs in a road match on July 11 at America First Field.

Tacoma forward Yu Tsukanome has scored nine goals this season, currently tied for second place in MLS NEXT Pro and one goal behind Whitecaps FC 2's Nelson Pierre.

Sounders FC forward Osaze De Rosario, who recently signed with the First Team, is tied for sixth in the league with eight goals.



Seattle goalkeeper Stefan Frei made two saves against Vancouver on June 8, putting him at 998 regular-season saves since joining Seattle prior to the 2014 season. Frei is looking to become only the second goalkeeper in MLS history to record 1,000 saves in the regular season for a single club, joining Nick Rimando, who made 1,128 saves with Real Salt Lake from 2007-2019.

Frei also recently passed 400 all-competition appearances for Seattle, becoming just the seventh player in MLS history to reach that mark with one club. The club captain helped Seattle win the 2014 U.S. Open Cup, 2014 Supporters' Shield, 2016 and 2019 MLS Cup as well as the 2022 Concacaf Champions Cup.



Over 150,000 fans packed Lumen Field over the last two weeks to watch Seattle take on some of the world's best teams in the FIFA Club World Cup 2025™. The Rave Green fought hard in each game, but ultimately bowed out of the tournament after losing their three Group Stage matches to 2024 South American champion Botafogo, Spanish power Atlético Madrid and 2025 UEFA Champions League winner Paris Saint-Germain.

Seattle fell 2-1 in its first match against Botafogo, with Cristian Roldan providing the goal for Seattle, but Seattle failed to find the equalizer down the stretch. Albert Rusnák then scored for Seattle in a 3-1 loss to Atlético Madrid, before falling 2-0 to Paris Saint-Germain.

The Rave Green were one of three MLS teams competing in the tournament, alongside LAFC and Inter Miami CF, and the only MLS side to qualify for the Club World Cup by winning the Concacaf Champions Cup, doing so in 2022.

For Sounders FC, all MLS matches – including the MLS Cup Playoffs – are set for air on Sports Radio 93.3 KJR FM, 950 KJR AM or on the iHeartRadio app. Each broadcast includes full pre and post-match shows, alongside live play-by-play throughout the MLS season.

For Reign FC, the new partnership with iHeartMedia Seattle provides the club a terrestrial radio and streaming audio platform for the first time in team history. This season, six matches will air on 950 KJR AM or via the iHeartRadio app, including a pre-match show and full in-match coverage. In subsequent seasons, 10 NWSL matches will be carried across iHeartMedia Seattle's platforms.

For fans of both clubs, leading Sports Radio KJR talent like Dave "Softy" Mahler, Dick Fain and Jackson Felts are set to be onsite at Lumen Field for select matches of both clubs, conducting live remotes, interacting with fans and appearing on the teams' pre-match shows, bringing fan-favorite voices directly to the Seattle soccer community.

Beyond in-match coverage throughout the MLS and NWSL seasons, iHeartMedia Seattle is invested in bringing Sounders and Reign fans closer to their teams through dedicated shoulder programming, weekly segments, interviews and cross-platform promotions. As Seattle prepares to host both the FIFA Club World Cup this summer and the FIFA World Cup next year, iHeartMedia Seattle is ramping-up its coverage, aligning Seattle's hometown teams with international soccer's biggest stages.

Sounders Weekly returns for its ninth season in 2025. The magazine-style weekly show on 93.3 KJR FM is hosted by Jackson Felts, offering insider updates, player interviews and analysis from around the soccer world every Wednesday throughout the season at 7:00 p.m. PT.

New in 2025, Sounders Weekly expands to 90 minutes to include a dedicated 30-minute Reign FC spotlight, featuring the club's players, coaches and top storylines.

In addition, Sounders FC Head Coach Brian Schmetzer's weekly segment on Dave "Softy" Mahler and Dick Fain's show continues every Tuesday at 5:45 p.m. PT throughout the MLS season, while fans of both teams can expect regular player and coach interviews across KJR's programming throughout the MLS and NWSL seasons. Additionally, team promotions, player audio drops and studio-produced promotional content will provide a steady drumbeat alongside match coverage and shoulder programming.



In a groundbreaking moment for Seattle soccer, Seattle Sounders FC and Seattle Reign FC on May 1 announced a historic multi-year partnership with FOX 13 Seattle, creating a unified broadcast platform for both clubs for the first time in the region's storied soccer history.

This landmark collaboration, designating FOX 13 Seattle as the Official Flagship Local Broadcast Partner of both Sounders FC and Reign FC, underscores the combined strength and growing impact of men's and women's professional soccer. It represents a major step forward in providing fans expansive and inclusive coverage, celebrating Seattle's rich soccer tradition on a shared stage.

Effective immediately, the first Reign FC contest on FOX 13's air kicks off on Friday, May 2 live from Lumen Field, as the home side takes on the Kansas City Current at 7:30 p.m. PT. For Sounders FC, the partnership includes a diverse array of shoulder programming, news and sports coverage, in addition to inseason specials and features throughout the year. Live Sounders FC matches continue to air on MLS Season Pass on Apple TV.

FOX 13 is continuing its strong coverage of Sounders FC and industry-leading reporting throughout the MLS season, and now becomes the official matchday broadcast home of Reign FC. Including onsite talent and production, this marks the first time in club history that Reign FC has integrated, on-location production services for its games. 11 NWSL matches are slated for air this season, with FOX 13's trusted on-air talent and dedicated crews providing blanket coverage, bringing fans closer to their favorite teams throughout the year.

Beyond match broadcasts, FOX 13 and the clubs are investing in expanded programming designed to deepen fan connections and build awareness of the many happenings across the Puget Sound soccer scene.

The new partnership features the following elements for Seattle soccer fans to enjoy.

- · Good Day Seattle: Regular player features and community storytelling segments for both Sounders FC and Reign FC on Seattle's number one morning show.
- · Washington Sports Wrap: Weekly updates covering both clubs, led by FOX 13's award-winning talent.
- · Team Vignettes: Bite-sized content throughout the season introducing players and coaches to the community.
- · Monthly Feature Stories: Human-interest stories highlighting athletes' journeys on and off the field of play.
- · Weekly Wrap Show: FOX 13's previous Sounders FC Weekly Wrap show now expands to include Reign FC coverage.
- · In-Season Specials: Special programming around key events such as kit launches, the FIFA Club World Cup and major rivalry matches.
- · Scarves Up! Returns: Monthly Sounders FC and Reign FC magazine show, exclusively produced by the club.

Furthermore, Sounders FC, Reign FC and FOX 13 are set to collaborate on community activations throughout the year, including RAVE Foundation mini-pitch openings, youth clinics and Kids Club initiatives, reinforcing soccer's role as a unifying force across the Seattle region.
