MATCH NOTES

• Thursday marks the first match between Seattle and Portland this season, as well as the first match for either team following the league's extended break for FIFA World Cup 2026™.

• Sounders FC currently sits in sixth place in the Western Conference with 24 points (7-3-3). Portland is in 13th place in the West with 14 points (4-8-2).

• Sunday will be the 43rd meeting between the two sides in MLS regular season play. Sounders FC leads the series 16-15-11.

• Dating back to 1974 in the North American Soccer League, the Sounders and Timbers have met 124 times across all competitions, with Seattle leading 58-47-19.

• Sounders FC will honor Jimmy Gabriel, Sigi Schmidt and Kasey Keller in a pre-match ceremony, the three newest entrants into Sounders FC Eternal Circle of Legends.

• Seattle has allowed only 11 goals in the regular season, tied for the fewest in MLS. The Rave Green have only surrendered more than one goal in a match on three occasions.

• Jackson Ragen was named to his first MLS All-Star Team this year, with the defender set to join the league's best in Charlotte later this month for a match against Liga MX's All-Stars.

• Brian Schmetzer currently has 148 regular-season wins since taking over the club in the summer of 2016. He is looking to become the ninth coach in MLS history to reach 150 regular-season wins.

• The Rave Green announced on July 15 that it has loaned defender Cody Baker to the New England Revolution for the remainder of the 2026 season. The loan can turn into a permanent transfer if certain performance-based incentives are met.

• Following Thursday's match, Seattle hits the road to take on Austin FC on Wednesday, July 22 at Q2 Stadium (5:30 p.m. PT / Apple TV, iHeartMedia Seattle, El Rey 1360 AM) and the Philadelphia Union on Saturday July 25 at Subaru Park (4:30 p.m. PT / Apple TV, iHeartMedia Seattle, El Rey 1360 AM).

DECADES OF DOMINANCE



The fiercest rivalry in American soccer returns to Seattle on Saturday when Sounders FC and the Portland Timbers meet at Lumen Field.



Dating back to 1975, Seattle and Portland have met 124 times (Seattle leads the all-time series 58-47-19), but records and standings are thrown out the window when these two teams take the field. The two sides have battled through six decades and five competitions, beginning with the North American Soccer League in 1975. The rivalry continued through Western Soccer League (WSL), United Soccer League (USL) and Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup play before reigniting at the topflight level in the 2011 MLS season.

2026 CASCADIA CUP

Thursday marks the first match of the 2026 Cascadia Cup for Seattle. Vancouver leads the stadnings with six points (2-0-0) following 4-1 and 3-2 win over Portland earlier this year. Seattle sits in second with zero points, tied with Portland but boasting a better goal differential.

The Cascadia Cup was formally started in 2004 by the largest supporters groups for each of the three clubs - Emerald City Supporters, Timbers Army and Vancouver Southsiders. The competition began when all three teams were members of the USL First Division and involves all three clubs, save for 2009 and 2010, when it was between the Timbers and the Whitecaps due to Seattle moving to MLS. In 2011, all three sides were in the MLS for the first time and the competition has existed in top division ever since.

2025 RECAP VS. PORTLAND



Seattle and Portland met twice in the regular season last year, with the Rave Green winning the series 1-0-1.

The first matchup took place at Providence Park on May 17, with the two sides drawing 1-1.

Albert Rusnák opened the scoring with a strike in the 30th minute from outside the area before Santiago Moreno equalized five minutes later. The score held the same for the rest of the match as each side went home with a point early in the season.

The two teams then met again for Seattle's last home match of the regular season. Pedro de la Vega scored the game's lone goal in the 16th minute, finishing off a great team effort to earn Seattle all three points against its archrival.

SCHMETZ LOOKS FOR 150 WINS



Seattle Sounders FC Head Coach Brian Schmetzer has amassed 148 regular-season wins since taking over the club in the summer of 2016. He is looking to become the ninth coach in MLS history to reach 150 regular-season wins, joining the likes of Bruce Arena, Sigi Schmid, Bob Bradley and other iconic coaches.

Since taking over in 2016, Schmetzer has helped Seattle win the 2016 and 2019 MLS Cups, 2022 Concacaf Champions Cup and Leagues Cup 2025 titles, currently holding a 148-92-81 record in regular season play.

FORTRESS AT LUMEN FIELD



Seattle's loss to the LA Galaxy on May 16, it's final home match before the FIFA World Cup 2026™ break, ended a 22-match unbeaten streak in all competitions (16-0-6) at Lumen Field, the longest streak in club history, topping the previous high of 17 matches unbeaten in 2017-2018 and 2020-2021. Prior to the match against the Galaxy, the Rave Green's last loss came against Paris Saint-Germain in the 2025 FIFA Club World Cup on June 23.

The Rave Green put together a 16-0-6 record at home in all competitions, including a 4-0-1 record in Leagues Cup 2025 play that saw the club capture the title in front of 69,314 at Lumen Field.

The club also had a run of 14 unbeaten regular season games (10-0-4) snapped, tied for the longest in club history and longest since the club had 14 straight unbeaten from 2020-2021.

Sounders FC has dominated behind its home crowd since it entered the league in 2009. Despite the loss to the Galaxy, the Rave Green have a 69 percent winning percentage (163-55-66) at Lumen Field, second to only LAFC's 73 percent, though Seattle has played 147 more home matches than LAFC.

RAGEN NAMED TO 2026 ALL-STAR TEAM



MLS announced on July 8 that Sounders FC defender Jackson Ragen has been named to the 2026 MLS All-Star roster.

Ragen, 28, has appeared in 16 games for Sounders FC in all competitions during the 2026 campaign, anchoring a defensive unit that is tied for first in MLS with just 11 goals allowed in regular-season play. Ragen continues to pair his aerial dominance with composure in possession, ranking 10th in MLS with 913 completed passes (with a 92% completion percentage) and recording an assist in a 2-1 win over FC Dallas on April 25. Ragen is one of 18 first-time All-Star selections on the 2026 roster.

SOUNDERS FC LOANS CODY BAKER



Sounders FC today announced on April 15 it has loaned defender Cody Baker to the New England Revolution through the end of the 2026 MLS season in exchange for New England's first-round pick in the 2027 MLS SuperDraft. If certain performance metrics are met during the 2026 season, the loan becomes a permanent transfer, with Seattle acquiring \$125,000 in 2027 General Allocation Money (GAM) and the 2027 first-round pick reverting to a 2028 second-round selection. Sounders FC could also receive up to an additional \$150,000 in GAM if certain performance metrics are met, in addition to retaining a percentage of any future trade or transfer.

Baker, 22, has made 37 all-competition appearances (17 starts) for Seattle since signing with the First Team in 2023. He tallied his first career assist for Sounders FC in 2023 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup action in a 5-4 extra-time win over San Diego Loyal (April 26, 2023), then bagged his first MLS assist against the San Jose Earthquakes the following season (March 23, 2024). Seattle loaned Baker to USL Championship side Sacramento Republic FC midway through the 2025 season, where he made six appearances (two starts) and totaled 284 minutes.

The Issaquah, Washington native originally joined the Sounders Discovery Program in 2015 before moving to Sounders FC Academy. He signed with Tacoma Defiance in July 2021, making 40 appearances (25 starts) with the club from 2021-2023, scoring one goal. While signed to the First Team, Baker made an additional 30 appearances for Tacoma, recording one goal and one assist.

THE EMERALD CITY SHOWS UP BIG FOR FIFA WORLD CUP 2026™



Seattle played host to six FIFA World Cup 2026™ matches over the course of the tournament, with hundreds of thousands of fans coming to the Emerald City for the once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. Outside of the walls of the stadium, the highlight was the Seattle Soccer Celebration. Put on by Sounders FC, Reign FC and RAVE Foundation, countless fans packed Pier 62 and the adjacent floating barge for watch parties and various activations throughout the course of the tournament in Seattle.

A FLOATING EXPRESSION OF SEATTLE'S SOCCER AUTHENTICITY

Located off of Pier 62 within Waterfront Park – the 20-acre civic waterfront reconnected to downtown Seattle through decades of public investment and community vision – Seattle Soccer Celebration transformed the shoreline into a global gathering place during one of the most significant moments in the city's modern history.

At the heart of Seattle Soccer Celebration is a custom-built soccer pitch constructed atop a maritime vessel, a striking visual and experiential centerpiece that brings the world's game directly to the water's edge. This is a place where matches, storytelling, culture and community converge in a way only Seattle can deliver.

Rooted in the region's deep maritime history and modern industrial spirit, the experience blends Seattle's working waterfront heritage with forward-looking innovation, creating a symbolic and immersive platform.

THE UNITED STATES MEN'S NATIONAL TEAM TAKES OVER SEATTLE

Seattle was fortunate enough to host the United States Men's National Team on two occasions during the month-long tournament, with its 2-0 Group Stage win over Australia, as well as its 4-1 Round of 16 loss to Belgium, taking place within the walls of Lumen Field.

Over 120,000 fans packed the stadium for the two matches, with hundreds of thousands more taking in the matches from watch parties all over the city, including a sold-out Pier 62 and floating barge at the Seattle Soccer Celebration for both matches.

INTERNATIONAL FANS DESCEND ON THE EMERALD CITY

Seattle enjoyed sold-out matches for every contest taking place in the Emerald City. Outside of the United States, the countries of Iran, Qatar, Egypt, Belgium, Australia, Senegal and Bosnia & Herzegovina played matches at Lumen Field, inviting fans from all over the world to experience Seattle. Countless international travelers enjoyed time at the Seattle Soccer Celebration as well, including both on Pier 62 and the floating barge.

CRISTIAN ROLDAN AT THE WORLD CUP

Seattle Sounder FC's own Cristian Roldan was named to the United States Men's National Team for the tournament. It was the second consecutive World Cup that Roldan had been called up for, also joining the United States during the 2022 edition of the tournament in Qatar, making the Sounders the only MLS team to have at least one player called up to the 2014, 2018 and 2022 USMNT roster. After being available for selection for the United States' first two Group Stage matches, he suffered an injury in training and was unavailable for selection the remainder of the tournament.

Overall, it was a historic summer for the city of Seattle, making the most of its time on the world stage as it welcomed an innumerable amount of fans. As always, the Emerald City rose to the occasion, living up to its name as one of the best soccer cities in America.
