Wednesday's RSL @ Seattle contest on Apple TV features **Brian Dunseth** and **Max Bretos** on the primary English-language call, while **Carlos Mauricio Ramirez** will provide the Spanish-language analysis ...

Simultaneously, the KSL Radio team of **David James** and **Jay Nolly** return to the mic, with **Nelson Moran** – now in his 22nd RSL season as RSL's Spanish radio voice – conducting the Spanish call on KBMG Latino 106.3 FM ...

ALL-TIME HISTORY AGAINST SEATTLE ::

Since the first meeting between the two sides in 2009, RSL holds a slight edge over Seattle, with an overall record of 20-17-9 (W-L-T) ... The home side has won five of the last six meetings between the teams, with RSL earning a 1-1 draw in Seattle back in 2024 ...

Earlier this season, the Sounders traveled to the Riot for RSL's home opener on February 28, suffering a 2-1 loss ... RSL opened up the scoring through 19-year-old Academy man **Aiden Hezarkhani**, who netted his first-ever MLS score in the 23rd minute ... Later, Australian striker **Ariath Piol** ultimately scored the game-winner for his lone goal of 2026, unfortunately ending his season in the 82nd minute after suffering a torn Achilles ...

DIEGO LUNA OUT FOR SIX MONTHS ::

RSL playmaker **Diego Luna** underwent a successful meniscus repair in his knee Friday in a procedure performed by U.S. Soccer Chief Medical Officer and orthopedic surgeon Dr. Bert Mandelbaum in Santa Monica, California ... The 22-year-old midfielder is now expected to miss approximately six months after suffering the knee injury back on Sept. 9 in Houston, while playing 70 minutes in the 2-1 road loss, with the meniscus tear identified via MRI a day later ...

Luna – who scored five goals and added eight assists in 22 games across all competitions this year for RSL – has returned to Utah to begin the rehabilitation process under the care of the Club's performance and medical group, in conjunction with Intermountain Health caretakers and facilities ...

"The surgery was a success and we are grateful to Dr. Mandelbaum," said **Dave Tenney**, Senior Director of High Performance for Real Salt Lake and Utah Royals FC. "Our job now is to provide structured, patient rehabilitation. Diego has the full support of our performance and medical staffs, as well as those of Intermountain Health, and he is already approaching the work the right way. We look forward to seeing him back on the field in 2027."

INTERNATIONAL DUTY CALLS::

In addition to Luna, two RSL players will miss this week's action due to the ongoing FIFA international break, as Uruguayan World Cup standout **Juan Manuel Sanabria** and Canadian World Cup centerback **Luc de Fougerolles** have departed for their nations' four-game slates ...

Trinidadian centerback **Kobi Henry** will join his country following Saturday's home New England match, as will U.S. Youth National Team standout **Colin Guske**; another USA youth international, RSL Academy midfielder **Luca Moisa**, will join his camp in progress after Wednesday's Seattle trip ...

SEVERAL YOUTH ALSO CALLED UP FOR FIFA PARTICIPATION ::

Later in the week, after the midweek Seattle contest, RSL will see a pair of its young defensive midfielders – Academy homegrown **Luca Moisa** and newcomer **Colin Guske** – participate in U.S. Youth National Team camps with the U23 and U20 teams ...

Attacker **Aiden Hezarkhani** will remain with RSL, engaging in first-team action ...



Additionally, Real Monarchs DF **Gio Calderon** will represent Puerto Rico on the senior stage, while **Antonio Riquelme** will participate with Chile's U-20 squad and RSL Academy man **Konstantinos Kyriazis** will represent the Greece U-17s ...

EMEKA ENELI RETURNS TO ACTION ::

Saturday's silver lining was the return of former captain and versatile fourth-year man **Emeka Eneli**, recovering from a persistent knee injury and resultant recovery to come off the bench to make his first appearance since last October's Wild Card playoff match at Portland ...

In the 64th minute, former RSL captain and 2025 USMNT midfielder **Emeka Eneli** made his return to the pitch for the first time in 11 months ... Eneli has been sidelined since last year's postseason with a complicated and progressively obstinate knee injury, making his last appearance in the West Wild Card match back on October 22, 2025, at Portland ...

Drafted by Real Salt Lake in the 2023 MLS SuperDraft out of Cornell, Eneli made his presence felt throughout the historic 2024 RSL campaign, recognized for his positional versatility and becoming the youngest captain in RSL's 22-year history in a road match at Kansas City ...

The former Ivy Leaguer capped off that year by winning the Club's 2024 Most Valuable Player award as voted by his peers, receiving his first callup to the U.S. Men's National Team ... Eneli earned two caps for the Stars-and-Stripes in January, 2025, amongst his 68 appearances for RSL, even scoring once back in a 2024 Audi MLS Cup Playoff match at Minnesota ...

Although his 2025 season was marred by a quadriceps injury, Eneli played a pivotal part in the 2025 MLS season as he was instrumental in the midfield, buoyed by his taste of national team success ...

INJURED LIST GETTING SHORTER ::

While the Sept. 12 NYCFC match also saw Colombian U22 centerback **Juan Jose Arias** suffer a 54th-minute hamstring strain that will see him – after starting in 10 of the last 12 matches for RSL – now out for an extended period of time, this past week has seen both **Stijn Spierings** and **Sam Junqua** return in addition to Emeka Eneli ...

Spierings suffered a high ankle sprain on August 25 just 20 minutes into the Leagues Cup Quarterfinal match against Leon ... Junqua's concussion was suffered four days later in the Club's 1-0 Rocky Mountain Cup loss in Denver ...

With the extended absences this year for Eneli, centerback **Justen Glad** (adductor) and forward **Ari Pjol** (achilles), RSL has seen 164 games lost due to injury, suspension or visa issues this year, the 12th-most of 30 teams in 2026, a total considered 5% higher than average ...

RSL IN SEARCH OF HOME COOKING ONCE AGAIN ::

Following the Seattle trip midweek, RSL remains home Saturday for the fourth of four September matches on Utah soil, looking to reclaim the Club's 2026 home dominance ... Despite back-to-back shutouts the last two weeks with the 0-3 against Vancouver Saturday and the 0-2 home loss to New York City FC on Sept. 5, as well as the 2-2 draw against LAFC on Sept. 5, RSL does boast an impressive 10-4-3 (W-L-T) overall record on Utah soil this season ... Recent setbacks in Sandy since the FIFA World Cup break have dropped the Claret-and-Cobalt to 18-7-5 (W-L-T) at its America First Field fortress since June 1, 2025 ...

The Sept. 12 loss against New York City marked the 13th and final match played in a 44-day span for RSL across both MLS and Leagues Cup competitions since the summer international break, a run that began with late July road losses at LAFC and Portland ...

While the Leagues Cup Phase One run was bookended by the St. Louis and Minnesota draws to create a five-game unbeaten streak amidst RSL's post-World Cup slate, the Club is now seeking to snap the dubious overall winless streak – now at 12 games, the longest during the five-year **Pablo Mastroeni** era and the third-longest in RSL's 22 seasons – with this week's Seattle trip ...

RARE HOME SHUTOUTS SUFFERED ::

Last Saturday at a sold-out America First Field – hosting its 15th consecutive MLS sellout, dating back to last August – RSL fell 0-3 to Vancouver on the heels of an 0-2 loss against a resurgent NYCFC, suffering back-to-back home shutouts for the first time since April, 2025 ...

Should RSL fail to score on the weekend against New England, it would go three consecutive home games without scoring for the first time since April/May, 2023 ...

When RSL's Sandy stadium opened, New England dropped both 6-0 and 5-0 visits in consecutive years (2009/10) ...



NEW BLOOD EMERGES DURING CONGESTED SCHEDULE ::

Newly-acquired attacking player **Taylor Booth** – a former RSL Academy star and a native of Eden, Utah – became the 14th Club debutant of 2026 and all-time RSL player No. 243 with his late appearance off the bench each of the last two weekends ...

Two other newcomers – DF **Luc de Fougerolles**, Canadian World Cup starter and FW **Dušan Žagar**, the 19-year-old Serbian winger, each of whom were added at the transfer window deadline on Sept. 2 – await their Club debuts ...

While Booth joined FW **Jason Shokalook**, MF **Colin Guske** and Academy M/F **Owen Anderson** in making their first-ever RSL appearances in recent weeks, nearly a dozen players were out due to injury or visa status during last week's three-game stretch ...

Pending visa approval, Canadian World Cup centerback **Luc de Fougerolles** would potentially see action on October 10 at Philadelphia, while Eneli, midfielder **Stijn Spierings** and defender **Sam Junqua** should all be available Wednesday in Seattle ...

RSL PREVIOUSLY DYNAMITE AGAINST THE DYNAMO ::

Last Wednesday night at Shell Energy Stadium in Houston, RSL fell 2-1 to extend its active road winless run to 11 games, last winning away from home back on March 7, when HC **Pablo Mastroeni**'s side won 3-2 at Atlanta ...

The midweek loss in Houston on the Dynamo's 87th-minute dagger snapped a three-game win streak against the Orange-and-Black, which took a 1-0 lead early in the second half, only to see RSL newcomer **Saba Lobjanidze** find the equalizer on **Lineker Rodrigues**' first-ever MLS assist ...

Lobjanidze's goal was his second in as many games, but the substitutes – including RSL Academy man **Owen Anderson**, making his RSL / MLS debut late – could not find a second equalizer ...

RSL arrived at Shell Energy Stadium in Houston Wednesday winners of its last three against the Dynamo, including a dominant 3-0 home win in Utah back on May 13, which saw RSL score all three in the second half, as a Houston own goal and a Xavier Gozo brace secured the full three points for RSL ...

The Utah side won both 2025 contests between the sides, including a 2-1 win in Houston last March that

saw **Diego Luna** provide the game-winning goal deep into first-half stoppage time, after RSL opened the scoring through Luna and **Emeka Eneli** for Diogo Gonçalves in the game's first minute ...

All-time, RSL owns a 14-11-9 (W-L-T) mark against the Dynamo, despite the Houston eliminations of RSL from both the 2023 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup at the Semifinal stage, and the 2023 Audi MLS Cup Playoffs, in a three-game First-Round series decided by a pair of penalty-kick shootout tiebreakers ...

REINFORCEMENTS INCOMING SATURDAY? ::

In recent weekends, newly-acquired FW **Jason Shokalook** became the 12th Club debutant of 2026 and all-time RSL player No. 241 with his late appearance off the bench, while two other newcomers – MF **Taylor Booth** and DF **Luc de Fougerolles**, each added at the transfer window deadline on Sept. 2 – await their Club debuts, as does FW **Dušan Žagar**, the 19-year-old Serbian winger ...

Back on August 29 at Colorado, another of RSL's all-time Club-high seven summer window additions, MF **Colin Guske**, became No. 240 in RSL's 22-year history to see MLS action, the loanee from Orlando playing the final 20+ minutes in Colorado ...

While both Shokalook and Guske made their first-ever RSL starts on Wednesday in Houston, with 13 players out due to injury or visa status, Saturday could see several midweek absences return to action against Vancouver ...

LAFC, HOUSTON COMEBACKS DISPLAY TRADEMARK xDAWG ::

Back on Sept. 5 at a standing-room only America First Field – hosting its 15th consecutive MLS sellout, dating back to last August – RSL drew 2-2 against star-studded LAFC, rebounding from a pair of one-goal deficits to snap a four-game losing streak ...

Summer window acquisition **Saba Lobjanidze** found the back of the net for the first time with RSL to tie it up 1-1 in the first half, while stalwart veteran **Noel Caliskan** buried the late equalizer off a rebound from **Aiden Hezarkhani** to split the points ...

Newly-acquired FW **Jason Shokalook** became the 12th Club debutant of 2026 and all-time RSL player No. 241 with his late appearance off the bench, while two other newcomers – MF **Taylor Booth** and DF **Luc de Fougerolles**, each added at the transfer window deadline last Wednesday – await their Club debuts, as



does FW **Dušan Žagar**, the 19-year-old Serbian winger ...

Back on August 29 at Colorado, another of RSL's all-time Club-high seven summer window additions, MF **Colin Guske**, became No. 240 in RSL's 22-year history to see MLS action, the loanee from Orlando playing the final 20+ minutes in Colorado ...

Real Salt Lake Head Coach **Pablo Mastroeni** has now managed the Club in 213 matches across all competitions, registering 85 wins, 78 losses and 50 draws in MLS, Audi MLS Cup Playoffs, Leagues Cup, Open Cup, Concacaf Champions Cup and international friendly contests since late August, 2021 ...

The former U.S. Men's National Team World Cup standout (2002, 2006), MLS Cup Champion (2010) as a player, and former Colorado Rapids manager (2014-16) has averaged 1.60 points per game with RSL in his 202 matches at the helm. Only Cup-winning former manager **Jason Kreis** (2007-13) – now the Club's President of Soccer – boasts more games, more wins and a higher PPG average than Mastroeni in RSL's 22 seasons.

During the Mastroeni era, resilience, grit and determination have served as trademarks for RSL, with the Club suffering back-to-back losses on just 24 occasions in those 213 games ... Wednesday's match at Seattle is the latest opportunity for the Claret-and-Cobalt to display its "xDAWG" mentality as it earned the result, now winning 35 and drawing 18 times in "bounce-back" games following a loss in Mastroeni's five-plus seasons in Utah ...

BRUTAL HISTORY FOR RSL AGAINST LAFC SINCE 2018 ::

RSL fell 3-1 at LAFC earlier this summer, in its first post-World Cup contest back on July 22 at BMO Stadium in Los Angeles ... Son and Bouanga each scored on blisteringly precise counterattacks in the first half of RSL's statistically-dominant performance, while RSL left centerback **Lukas Engel** scored late to avoid the shutout suffered, his first goal in 50 Major League Soccer contests ...

All-time, RSL is still just 4W-16L-2T against the 2018 MLS expansion side, with the Black-and-Gold giving RSL its worst-ever home loss with a 5-1 win in that year's Sandy opener ...

COLORADO CRASHOUT CONTINUES 2026 ROCK BOTTOM SLIDE ::

In the final week of August, RSL dropped both matches at Dick's Sporting Goods Park in Commerce City, where it was eliminated 3-0 a week ago Tuesday from the 2026 Leagues Cup at the Quarterfinal stage by Liga MX top-seed Club León, before falling 1-0 on yet another set-piece corner kick concession with a half-hour remaining in MLS reg. season action on August 29 ...

A rotated RSL arrived Saturday looking to snap three active streaks: the now four-game losing streak across all competitions, the now eight-game winless run in MLS action dating back to May 16, and the now nine-game road run without a win since March 7, when HC **Pablo Mastroeni**'s side won 3-2 at Atlanta ...

RSL has now fallen at Colorado by one-goal margins in each of its last three visits, in 2024, 2025 and 2026, on the heels of four straight unbeaten there in 2022/23 ...

All-time, RSL still boasts a 26-11-9 (W-L-T) mark against the Rapids in MLS reg. season play, including a 10-14-6 (W-L-T) mark in the Centennial state ...

RSL last captured the Rocky Mountain Cup in 2023, its seventh consecutive RMC (excluding the disputed 2020 award); overall, RSL had won 14 of the previous 21 editions, failing in Saturday's opportunity to re-establish dominance in the series with a win or draw ...

2026 SUMMER TRANSFER WINDOW WRAP-UP – INCOMING ::

On Sept. 2, RSL completed its activity during the two-month-long MLS secondary transfer window, ultimately adding a Club-record SEVEN players to the roster entering the final 13 matches of the 2026 MLS reg. season and potentially playoffs ...

Headlining the group of additions is 25-year-old Eden, Utah native **Taylor Booth**, a two-way midfielder / inverted winger arriving on a one-year loan from FC Twente in the Dutch Eredivisie, now sharing a roster with his younger brother, Zach, for the first time nearly a decade, since the duo's RSL Academy days in spring of 2018 ...

Also arriving last week, on a permanent transfer from the Chicago Fire (MLS), is FW **Jason Shokalook**, the 2025 MLS NEXT Pro Golden Boot winner, coming off 20 goals in 22 appearances last year ...



Another purchase was made this week when RSL permanently acquired 19-year-old Serbian MF **Dušan Žagar** via transfer from FK IMT Belgrade of the Serbian Super Liga ... The Club's latest U22 roster designation is signed through the conclusion of the 2028/29 MLS Season, with RSL owning two option years through June 30, 2031 ... Žagar amassed 42 appearances for IMT Belgrade as a teenager in the last 18 months, scoring three goals ...

Finally, a six-month loan for Canadian World Cup centerback **Luc de Fougerolles** was made publicly official on Saturday, pending various P-1 visa and International Transfer Certificate paperwork processing ... The Fulham FC (England) loanee could potentially see his loan extended to include the 2027 MLS Sprint Season as well ...

These four moves at the deadline come on the heels of three other additions during the last 60 days: M/F **Saba Lobjanidze** (acquired via July 1 trade from Atlanta United), MF **Colin Guske** (loaned from Orlando on Aug. 21) and MF **Lineker Rodrigues** dos Santos (upgraded from MLS NEXT Pro contract with Real Monarchs to RSL in early August) ...

2026 SUMMER TRANSFER WINDOW WRAP-UP – OUTGOING ::

Also on Sept. 2, RSL completed a trade that sees nine-year veteran MF **Pablo Ruiz** sent to the LA Galaxy in exchange for \$400,000 in GAM, with Ruiz' contract expiring in December ...

Finally, RSL was able to execute a loan move for Nigerian FW **Victor Olatunji** to SK Beveren (Belgium), while a pending loan move back to Europe for winger **Dominik Marczuk** has fallen through, with the former Polish Young Player of the Year arriving back in Utah late Monday, training fully this week in Herriman and appearing Saturday against Vancouver ...

ROAD TO THE 2026 LEAGUES CUP QUARTERFINAL ::

RSL has to find solace in becoming one of the final four MLS sides out of 18 in the 2026 Leagues Cup tournament, the Claret-and-Cobalt advancing to last week's Quarterfinal stage by outscoring a trio of Mexican visitors 8-1 in August at its America First Field home, with RSL riding six different goalscorers and employing 19 different starters ...

RSL's 2026 Leagues Cup Phase One trio of performances improved RSL to 8-6-6 all-time (29-25 aggregate goals) against Mexican visitors on Utah soil in the last 22 seasons, with a 20-10-10 mark on the Wasatch Front against all international opponents ...

RSL's back-to-back clean sheets in its 4-0 win Aug. 8 against Atlante and the 3-0 victory Aug. 11 against Juarez are just the second set of shutouts in the 64-game **Rafael Cabral** era (2025/26), with the combined 7-0 aggregate over those 180 minutes the most dominant consecutive games in RSL's 22-year, 850-plus game history across all competitions ...

KNOCKOUT HISTORY FOR RSL ::

With the August 25 neutral-site loss to Leon, RSL failed to advance to what would have been its third Semifinal contest in the five-year **Pablo Mastroeni** era ... Advancement would have marked RSL's first since the 2023 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup, where it lost at Houston, 3-1, after extra time ... Back in 2021, RSL also advanced to the MLS Western Conference Final, falling at Portland ...

RSL has now played 15 elimination games during its five-year history with Mastroeni as manager, winning six, with only one prior match approaching "neutral-site" status ...

During the 2025 CONCACAF Champions Cup Round of 32, RSL kicked off a two-leg series with Costa Rican champions Herediano, playing the first leg in the country's National Stadium in San José ... RSL drew 0-0 that day in GK **Rafael Cabral**'s first-ever match with the Utah side, which fell 1-2 at home in the second leg a week later ...

In recent years, RSL has seen various means of elimination in knockout situations, bookended by road losses in the Audi MLS Cup Playoffs at Portland – last year in the Western Conference Wild Card Round, and in the 2021 Western Conference Final ...

In MLS postseason games decided by penalty-kick shootout tiebreakers, RSL was eliminated in 2022 at Austin, 2023 at Houston and 2024 against Minnesota, advancing only in 2021 at Seattle ...

In the 2022 Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup, RSL fell at home in a massive upset to the Northern Colorado Hailstorm playing its third competitive match ever ... During RSL's 2023 USOC Semifinal run, the Club won in extra time at Las Vegas before regulation wins at Portland, at Colorado and against LA Galaxy prior to its 120-minute loss at Houston ... The 2024 Open Cup tourney saw RSL lose in regulation away at New Mexico United (USL Championship) ...



CONGESTED SLATE HINGES ON RSL SNAPPING DUBIOUS STREAKS ::

Earlier this year against Colorado, RSL rookie **Sergi Solans** found the back of the net for the game-winner against Colorado in a come-from-behind, 2-1 RSL victory ... Colorado took the early lead at America First Field in Sandy with a seventh-minute goal, but a Xavier Gozo equalizer sent RSL into halftime tied at 1-1 ...

Solans' game-winner back on May 16 – incidentally RSL's last MLS reg. season win – was one of his Club-high 13 goals this season (nine in MLS, two in Leagues Cup, two in the Burnley friendly) ... The active RSL Golden Boot leader has already set a new RSL rookie scoring record, breaking Corey Baird's eight-goal total during his MLS Rookie of the Year season in 2019 ...

RSL's Major League Soccer regular-season return also looks to reverse a trend of dropped points late, with the 81st-minute concession in a 2-1 loss at Orlando on August 22 fresh in the collective soul following a 3-4 loss against FC Dallas in RSL's last home game on August 19, which saw a stoppage-time winner drop RSL to 10-2-2 (W-L-T) overall on Utah soil in 2026 ...

Two months ago, RSL conceded in the 89th minute against Minnesota, forced to settle for a 1-1 draw against the visiting Loons, the Claret-and-Cobalt now 18-5-4 (W-L-T) at its America First Field fortress since June 1, 2025 ...

Saturday's Sept. 12 match against NYCFC was the 13th amidst a critical stretch of 13 games in 44 days for RSL across both MLS and Leagues Cup contests, a run that began with late July road losses at LAFC and Portland ...

While the St. Louis draw on Aug. 1 snapped a two-game losing streak in RSL's post-World Cup slate following losses at LAFC on July 22 and at Portland on July 25, the Club now forced to carry an active 10-game winless streak away from home into its next road match, Sept. 23 at Seattle in a game rescheduled from April 12, when Lumen Field concerns forced the pre-World Cup move ...

LATE POINTS DROPPED YET AGAIN ::

On August 22 in Orlando, second-year RSL winger **Dominik Marczuk** – scoring his first goal since April 12, 2025, in a 2-1 road loss at Nashville – gave RSL a 1-0 lead for the fourth occasion in a five-match MLS span ...

As it had back on July 25 at Portland (Guilavogui red card), August 1 at St. Louis (Hartel equalizer) and

August 15 at home against Minnesota (89th-minute concession), RSL coughed up the advantage ...

When scoring first during the Mastroeni era, RSL is now 56-12-22 (W-L-T) since August, 2021, while taking a 1-0 lead ...

Throughout the 2026 season, RSL has lacked success away from home, the Club earning just one road win – back on March 7 in a 3-2 win at Atlanta – against three draws and now eight losses away, the active road winless streak now at 11 games overall ... RSL is now just 1-8-3 away from home in 2026 ...

NEWFOUND DEPTH DISCOVERED IN HEAVY ROTATION AT ORLANDO? ::

A month ago in Orlando, RSL boss Mastroeni made 10 changes to the XI from Wednesday's 3-4 loss to Dallas, with three RSL regulars – Golden Boot leader **Sergi Solans**, USMNT veteran **DeAndre Yedlin** and Dutch newcomer **Stijn Spierings** – not even dressing ...

RSL GK **Mason Stajduhar** made his Club debut in his Orlando homecoming, supplanting Brazilian Captain **Rafael Cabral** and snapping his 63-game, 5,800+-minute streak over all 2025/26 competitions ...

21-year-old centerback **Kobi Henry** also made his MLS first-team debut for the Club, starting and providing an impressive 90 minutes for the first time since the 2025 CONCACAF Champions Cup starts against Herediano last year ...

A pair of 18-year-old RSL Academy homegrowns each made their first starts in an extended period, as attacking mid **Aiden Hezarkhani** returned to the XI for the first time since May 23 at Minnesota, and holding mid **Luca Moisa** started for the first time since playing 45 minutes on March 7 at Atlanta ...

RSL last made 10 changes to a lineup multiple times back in 2023 during its Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup run; with Tuesday's León match seeing a full 11-man rotation from the Orlando match, ahead of six personnel changes last week in Colorado ...

RED-HOT ROOKIE SERGI SOLANS COOLING OFF LAST MONTH ::

Despite being shut out in Colorado in late August against both Leon and the Rapids, five of RSL's previous six August matches saw RSL rookie **Sergi Solans** find the back of the net, scoring a Club-high 13 goals this season (nine in MLS, two in Leagues Cup, two in the Burnley friendly) ... The RSL Golden Boot



leader has set a new RSL rookie scoring record, breaking Corey Baird's eight-goal total during his MLS Rookie of the Year season in 2019, seeing his active four-game scoring run snapped in the Leagues Cup Quarterfinal against León, failing to match former RSL captain Damir Kreilach's record five-game scoring streak, accomplished in Sept.-Oct., 2021 ...

WELCOME COLIN GUSKE ::

On the eve of RSL's trip to Orlando, the clubs agreed on a six-month loan deal to send young midfielder **Colin Guske** from Florida to Utah for the remainder of the 2026 season ... RSL sends \$50,000 in 2026 General Allocation Money to OCSC for Guske, a 20-year-old holding midfielder who had excelled for the USA U-20 side in Concacaf qualifying ...

Guske has appeared in 16 first team games in his young career, starting four, while also making 45 MLS NEXT Pro appearances for the Lions' B team in 2025/26 ...

SOLANS STRIKE RATE JOINED BY GUILAVOGUI, LUNA v DALLAS ::

In RSL's home game on August 19 in a 3-4 loss to Dallas, RSL saw current Golden Boot leader **Sergi Solans** set a new Club rookie scoring record, breaking Corey Baird's eight-goal total during his MLS Rookie of the Year season in 2019 ...

On that day against Dallas, RSL climbed back from a 1-3 halftime deficit courtesy of early second-half goals by French-born DP **Morgan Guilavogui** – scoring his third goal overall (and second in as many appearances, after sitting out last Saturday against Minnesota) and his second in MLS action this year – and star playmaker **Diego Luna**, who assisted on the Solans and Guilavogui goals before scoring one of his own, his fifth on the season to go with eight assists across all competitions in 2026 ...

HISTORIC LEAGUES CUP GOAL EXPLOSION IN SANDY ::

Prior to the August 19 first-half meltdown, since returning home on August 4, RSL had conceded just two goals in four matches across MLS and Leagues Cup, with a staunch 353-minute shutout streak carrying back-to-back clean sheets in its 4-0 win Aug. 8 against Atlante and the 3-0 victory Aug. 11 against Juarez, between the sixth-minute goal allowed Aug. 4 against Tigres and the 89th-minute heartbreaker allowed Saturday against Minnesota ...

RSL's seven goals scored over the two shutout matches represent the most in the Club's nearly 850 all-time contests in the last 22 years ...

RSL GK and Captain **Rafael Cabral** – who had played every minute of 69 games out of 70 across all competitions the last two years (excluding last Saturday at Orlando) – registered consecutive shutouts for the first time since July, 2025, and just the second time this season, for a total of four clean sheets across all comps during the ongoing campaign ...

JUAREZ DISMISSED WITH DOMINANT RSL SHOW ::

Back on Aug. 11, RSL earned its second consecutive Leagues Cup clean sheet, defeating Liga MX side FC Juarez (0-3-0, 0 points, 18th Liga MX) with an impressive 3-0 victory to finish out Phase One in dominant fashion in front of a home crowd of 14,099 fans at America First Field ...

French-born DP **Morgan Guilavogui** – with his first-ever RSL start up top at striker – gave RSL the first-half lead with a 29th-minute penalty after securing his second 2026 goal across all competitions (MLS, international friendly, Leagues Cup), while rookie Spanish striker **Sergi Solans** netted his third goal in four games and second in as many matches ...

Another MLS rookie, newly-signed **Lineker Rodrigues dos Santos**, capped off the evening in the 68th minute, scoring his first-career MLS goal ... the Brazilian-born Lineker – named by his father after famed footballer Gary, who scored in spectacular fashion for England against Brazil in a friendly at Wembley – was named both the Leagues Cup and FotMob "Man of the Match" for his 90-minute performance against Juarez ...

LOOKING BACK AT ATLANTE DISMANTLING ::

RSL's 4-0 win August 8 in Sandy over Atlante was the Club's first four-goal win since mid-2024, featuring four different goalscorers as well ... RSL's 2026 Golden Boot leader, Spanish rookie **Sergi Solans**, scored his 10th of now 11 goals across all competitions, opening his Leagues Cup account to go with seven in MLS reg. season play, as well as a brace in the 4-1 exhibition win over Burnley in mid-July ...

Solans' game-winner came in the 16th minute, with a duel won by **Morgan Guilavogui** and the primary assist coming from **Diego Luna**, the first of two assists on the night for the U.S. World Cup snub ...



Just five minutes into the second half, RSL blew the game open with a pair of goals in short succession, as Eden, Utah native **Zach Booth** – making just his sixth start of the season – scored his first-ever home goal (and second overall) with a blistering left-footed shot from 18 yards out ...

Shortly thereafter, Danish centerback **Lukas Engel** deftly redirected a Guilavogui pass off a Luna free kick, the former Middlesbrough and FC Cincinnati defender scoring his second goal in the last five matches – and first-ever for RSL at home – after being shut out in his first 49 career MLS appearances ...

Wrapping up RSL's first four-goal win in more than two years was veteran RSL midfielder **Pablo Ruiz**, who followed up his August 4 equalizer – his first goal since a midfield bombazo in June, 2023, at D.C. United, a span of just 35 games played across 1,444 days due to two severe knee injuries for the metronomic, deep-lying playmaker – with a hard, left-footed shot far post after picking the Atlante player's pocket for his second goal of the week ...

NEWFOUND RSL DEPTH AMONGST HEAVY LEAGUES CUP ROTATION ::

While heavy rotation has been the rule during the ongoing gauntlet of matches, RSL has discovered newfound depth, as 19 different players have started during the ongoing Leagues Cup run ...

The quick turnarounds and schedule congestion for RSL Head Coach **Pablo Mastroeni** has forced the RSL staff to make 8, then 6 and 6 changes again game-to-game, prior to Tuesday's fully-rotated starting XI against León ...

Regular first-choice men FW **Sergi Solans**, playmaker **Diego Luna** and Utah native **Zach Booth** have each bounced from the XI to bench, as have perennial starters **Noel Caliskan**, veteran **DeAndre Yedlin** and newcomer **Stijn Spierings** ...

Veteran RSL midfielder **Pablo Ruiz** has contributed with his first starts and goals of 2026, while MF **Saba Lobjanidze**, DF **Juan Jose Arias** and M/F **Lineker Rodrigues** have each made their America First Field debuts ...

Well-rested Uruguayan World Cup star **Juan Manuel Sanabria** returns to the XI, as well as veteran defender **Sam Junqua**, who last started Aug. 1 at St. Louis ...

RSL Academy product **Zach Booth** is now out for an extended period of time due to his Aug. 15 hamstring strain, while former Captain **Emeka Eneli** could return soon ...

SUCCESSFUL GRIFFIN DILLON SURGERY A MONTH AGO ::

RSL homegrown MF **Griffin Dillon** underwent successful surgery August 5 to repair a broken fifth metatarsal in his right foot, the injury suffered in the 41st minute of the 1-1 draw at St. Louis on August 1 ... The procedure was performed by Dr. David A. Joos at Utah Valley Orthopedic Clinic, an Intermountain Health facility ...

Dillon – a Draper, Utah native who played briefly at the Univ. of Maryland, before returning to Real Monarchs and earning an MLS contract in 2025 – has started four games this season for RSL ... The injury will likely shelve Dillon for close to 12 weeks ...

POST-WORLD CUP BLEEDING STOPPED AT ST. LOUIS ::

While RSL's 1-1 draw just over two weeks ago at St. Louis prevented the Claret-and-Cobalt from securing its first road win since March 7 in Atlanta, RSL did snap a two-game road losing streak thanks to rookie FW **Sergi Solans'** team-high seventh goal of the season, and a brilliant assist from newcomer **Saba Lobjanidze** ...

RSL now owns an all-time 3-1-3 (W-L-T) record in seven all-time meetings against the 2023 expansion side, including a win and now three draws at Energizer Park ... RSL last visited St. Louis on Decision Day 2025, drawing 2-2 despite an early **Victor Olatunji** brace, with the Utah side conceding a late equalizer in the 88th minute, briefly jeopardizing RSL's postseason qualification hopes ...

RSL finished its pre-hiatus schedule with a 3-1-1 mark, conceding late in its last match at Minnesota, forced to settle for a disappointing draw that saw Utah native **Zach Booth** score his first-ever MLS goal, the draw at the Loons following back-to-back home wins against Houston and Colorado ...

ALL-STAR GOZO HAD RETURNED TO UTAH – BUT NOW TRANSFERRED ::

Despite missing the weekend trip to St. Louis earlier this month with a hip strain, Real Salt Lake homegrown phenom **Zavier Gozo** was back with the Club after logging a successful 27-minute shift off the bench in late July alongside some of the world's biggest stars in a 4-3 MLS victory over Liga MX to conclude the week's 2026 MLS All-Star festivities ...

Substituting on in the 63rd minute, Gozo officially became the 13th all-time RSL representative selected



in the Club's 22-year history, the youngest-ever RSL All-Star at just 19 years, 4 months, and 2 days old ...

The Utah native – the Beehive State's first-ever voted to the "First XI" by players, fans and media – now joins teammates **Diego Luna** (2025, 2024) and **Justen Glad** (2024) to earn the honors, whilst etching his name into a historic list of Claret-and-Cobalt legends comprised of such Club icons as:

Damir Kreilach (2021),
Nick Rimando (2019, 2015, 2014, 2013, 2011, 2010),
Kyle Beckerman (2016, 2014, 2013, 2012, 2011, 2010, 2009, 2007),
Tony Beltran (2015, 2013),
Fabian Espindola (2012),
Jamison Olave (2012, 2011, 2010),
Javier Morales (2010, 2009),
Will Johnson (2009);
 and **Eddie Pope** (2007, 2005);

Meanwhile, **Jason Kreis** was named to an MLS "select" team in RSL's inaugural 2005 season that traveled to face Real Madrid ...

"It was so much fun, especially to play with the best players in the world," stated Gozo post-game. "They [Son Heung-Min, Thomas Müller and Carles Gil] told me to keep going, keep fighting, keep smiling and playing the way I have been playing. They've been very encouraging."

Unfortunately for RSL, Gozo has missed each of the three Leagues Cup Phase One matches as well as the 1-1 draw with Minnesota on Aug. 15, prior to the finalization of his Club-record transfer to Crystal Palace, announced on August 18 ...

PERSONAL MILESTONES HIGHLIGHT POST-WORLD CUP ROAD WOES ::

In the July 22 statistically-dominant yet disappointing loss at LAFC, RSL did celebrate some individual milestones ... In the 88th minute, RSL avoided the shutout suffered when DF **Lukas Engel** scored his first-ever MLS goal, in his 50th game in the League ... Engel's lefty blast was his first professional goal since March, 2024, for Middlesbrough against Norwich City in the EFL Championship, prior to his 2025 loan to FC Cincinnati and subsequent transfer this January to Real Salt Lake ...

Assisting on the Engel goal was second-half substitute **Saba Lobjanidze**, the early July acquisition from Atlanta making his RSL debut ... With his dynamic late minutes, the Georgian international provided service and danger, earning an assist on the corner kick to Engel ... "Saba" became the eighth all-time RSL player

to assist in his debut and the 14th to provide a goal contribution in his first-ever Claret-and-Cobalt contest, also becoming RSL's all-time player No. 237 to log MLS minutes for the Utah side ...

Three days later, Uruguyan World Cup standout **Juan Manuel Sanabria** scored his first-ever RSL/MLS goal to give the Claret-and-Cobalt the early lead at Portland, prior to a **Morgan Guilavogui** red card in the 34th minute ... Later in that match, Colombian U22 defender **Juan Jose Arias** became the 13th debutant for RSL this season and all-time RSL player No. 238 ...

August 1 at St. Louis, Real Monarchs standout and 2025 RSL SuperDraft pick **Lineker Rodrigues dos Santos** made his first-ever MLS start, appearing in the lineup as a second striker alongside Solans, with DP 10 Guilavogui suspended due to his violent conduct red card at Portland the prior week ... Lineker also started earlier this week against Juarez, named the Leagues Cup and FotMob Man of the Match for his 90-minute performance, scoring his first-ever RSL goal ...

FIRST BLOOD HUGELY IMPORTANT FOR RSL UNDER MASTROENI ::

Scoring first on Wednesday against Houston – and not conceding minutes later, as it did each of the two Saturdays against Orlando and Minnesota, as well as at St. Louis on Aug. 1, or going a man down 10 minutes later, as it did at Portland on July 25 – is critical for RSL's success, as the 2025 campaign saw the Utah side win just once in come-from-behind fashion (July 26 at San Jose), as it did in the March 14 win over Austin FC as well as the mid-May home win against Colorado ... RSL scored first in 23 of its 40 games last year, while posting a 12W-7L-5T when drawing first blood against its opposition ...

With the Orlando loss on August 22, RSL has now recorded a 56W-12L-22T record when scoring first during the 213-game Mastroeni era, with all but one of 13 RSL victories last season coming when taking the 1-0 lead ... Seven of the 12 losses under Mastroeni when taking the 1-0 lead since August, 2021, came during last year's 2025 campaign ...

This year, RSL has TWO come-from-behind wins, falling behind at home to both Colorado and Austin earlier this year before clawing back to claim the full three points ... The Sept. 5 pair of comebacks against LAFC for the 2-2 draw marked the second time RSL equalized late, the first being March 22 at San Diego ...



BURNLEY TUNE-UP PREPARED RSL FOR UPCOMING GAUNTLET ::

Now with 14 league games remaining in its 22nd all-time MLS season, RSL has resumed its 2026 MLS campaign four weeks removed from last month's 4-1 exhibition win over English Championship side Burnley FC ... The first of at least four international clubs to arrive on the Wasatch Front during a 30-day midsummer span, Burnley was denied early by a sixth-minute penalty-kick save from Captain **Rafael Cabral**, later buoyed by a brace from rookie FW **Sergi Solans**, the Club's co-Golden Boot leader with Utah native and teenager **Zavier Gozo**, who also added a goal and an assist on the night ...

RSL star **Diego Luna** converted a late penalty to determine the final margin, with Burnley becoming the 33rd of 35 different international opponents to compete on Utah soil against Real Salt Lake, which now boasts an all-time 20W-10L-10T mark against international visitors with the recent Tigres, Atlante and Juarez matches ...

The Burnley home match afforded RSL Head Coach **Pablo Mastroeni**'s side – then with an 8-6-3 (W-L-T) record, good for 27 points – the opportunity to improve on it's then dominant 10-1-2 (W-L-T) mark at home this season, before resuming the bulk of its 2026 MLS reg. season campaign ...

EARLIER THIS SEASON, RSL CHOPPED DOWN TIMBERS ::

Prior to the mid-May Houston/Colorado contests, in its previous home win back on May 2, RSL snapped its two-game losing streak with a dominant first-half performance against visiting Portland, as USA World Cup hopefuls **Zavier Gozo** (10th minute) and **Diego Luna** (28th minute) each found the back of the net against the Timbers ...

Uruguayan international **Juan Manuel Sanabria** assisted on both goals, while rookie **Sergi Solans** also tallied an assist ... French-born playmaker **Morgan Guilavogui** was also dangerous on the attack, slamming a long-distance shot off the crossbar and seeing multiple breakaways snuffed out ... Holding mids **Noel Caliskan** and **Stijn Spierings** also saw dangerous attacking opportunities saved in an impressive performance by Timbers 'keeper James Pantemis ...

ROCKY MOUNTAIN CUP COMEBACK DRIVEN BY GOZO, SOLANS ::

The mid-May 2-1 comeback win over Rocky Mountain Cup rival Colorado was a professional victory, RSL conceding a "soft" goal early, according to Mastroeni, going down 0-1 in the game's seventh minute on a corner kick that was never properly dealt with ...

Late in the first half, a high press by the hard-working former RSL Academy man **Zach Booth** – starting his first of two consecutive late May matches since the two February MLS matchdays – created a turnover off a deflection, the ball squirting to rookie RSL FW **Sergi Solans**, who set up red-hot Utah teenager **Zavier Gozo** with the 38th minute equalizer ...

The goal for Gozo was his fourth in a five-game MLS span, THEN his team-leading sixth of the season, to go along with five assists ...

In the 68th minute, Solans got his head to an exquisite **Juan Manuel Sanabria** cross for the game-winning score to give RSL the 2-1 result ... Solans moved into the 2026 RSL Golden Boot lead with Gozo, both at six goals this year prior to Solans' seventh Saturday in St. Louis ...

The Solans header was his third of the season, as was his game-winner, the college rookie also providing the decisive scores in the 4-2 win over San Diego and the 2-1 win over Kansas City ...

STRONG SECOND-HALF WAKE-UP CALL v HOUSTON ::

Also in early May, RSL rode a brace from 19-year-old **Zavier Gozo**, making the Utah native the youngest-ever multi-goal scorer in the Claret-and-Cobalt's 22-year history ... Gozo, at 19 years / 52 days, broke the three-year-old record set by **Diego Luna**, back in July, 2023, when he was 19 years / 311 days, at home in a win over New York Red Bulls ahead of his USA U-20 foray in France ...

Following a sleepy first-half, RSL struck early in the second, when a long **DeAndre Yedlin** throw-in was headed into Houston's own goal, giving RSL a 1-0 lead ... 10 minutes later, a 60-yard run by Yedlin set up the first of two Gozo goals, the West Valley-born teen completing the brace on a **Stijn Spierings** primary assist ...

RSL GK **Rafael Cabral** also received credit for the secondary assist on the first Gozo goal, becoming the first Claret-and-Cobalt 'keeper since Gavin Beavers



back in August, 2024, on a midfield goal by former RSL man Anderson Julio ...

ZAVIER GOZO FIRST-EVER UTAH NATIVE NAMED TO MLS ALL-STAR FIRST XI ::

Back in early June, Real Salt Lake, in conjunction with Major League Soccer, announced the First XI players named to the 2026 MLS All-Star Game presented by Chime, an 11-man group featuring Utah's very own **Zavier Gozo** ... Selected through a combined vote of MLS fans, players, and media members, 19-year-old attacker Gozo and the First XI highlights the standout performers from the first part of the MLS regular season ... The 11 players include icons like Lionel Messi (Inter Miami CF) and Son Heung-Min (LAFC), alongside breakout young talents such as Gozo and Mbekezeli Mbokazi (Chicago Fire FC) ...

"It's pretty cool to be the first-ever Utah player to be named an All-Star in MLS," said Gozo, the third RSL Academy homegrown player to earn MLS All-Star recognition (Justen Glad, Aaron Herrera). "I'm very grateful to all the fans, players and media across the league for recognizing me with this prestigious honor."

"I look forward to hopefully having a few of my RSL teammates join me in Charlotte, and I'll be very excited to get back on the field and get things going again later this Summer."

The 2026 MLS All-Star Game presented by Chime will be played in Charlotte, N.C., pitting the MLS All-Stars against a team of All-Stars from Mexico's top soccer league, LIGA MX, next Wednesday, July 29 (6 p.m. MT) at Charlotte FC's Bank of America Stadium ...

One of three domestic products (Gozo, Markanich, Schwake), West Valley-born and Eagle mountain-raised Gozo becomes the youngest-ever RSL representative at the annual MLS All-Star Game at just 19 years old, surpassing **Diego Luna's** 20-year-old selection at the 2024 All-Star game in Columbus ... Gozo also becomes just the second teenager to be

selected to an MLS All-Star Game in the last five editions, joining Obed Vargas (2025) ...

Gozo's six goals in 16 games this season had him tied atop the 2026 RSL Golden Boot leaderboard with rookie **Sergi Solans**, with last year's USA U-20 star Gozo leading the Claret-and-Cobalt way in goal contributions with 11 (6 goals, 5 assists) entering the FIFA World Cup Break ... Etching his name into the record books on multiple occasions, Gozo became the youngest in RSL's 22-year history to record two or more goals in a game back on May 13 in a 3-0 home victory over Houston, at just 19 years and 54 days old; that brace eclipsed the previous mark, set nearly three years ago, held by current teammate Luna, who was 19 years and 311 days old back on July 15, 2023 ...

Gozo's pursuit of Major League Soccer's all-time record for game-winning goal contributions by a teenager remains in effect, with this year's total of five combined game-clinching goals/assists placing him second all-time, the Utah native remaining three GWCs shy of Diego Fagundez' mark of eight game-winning contributions in 31 games for the 2013 New England Revolution ...

Gozo's 2026 MLS All-Star selection is the most recent of the Utah Club's 22-year history, joining **Diego Luna** (2025, 2024), **Cristian Arango** (2024), **Justen Glad** (2024) and **Damir Kreilach** (2021) from the Pablo Mastroeni era ...

Previous RSL players honored with MLS All-Star selections include **Nick Rimando** (2019, 2015, 2014, 2013, 2011, 2010), **Kyle Beckerman** (2016, 2014, 2013, 2012, 2011, 2010, 2009, 2007), **Tony Beltran** (2015, 2013), **Fabian Espindola** (2012), **Jamison Olave** (2012, 2011, 2010), **Javier Morales** (2010, 2009), **Will Johnson** (2009) and **Eddie Pope** (2007, 2005), while **Jason Kreis** was named to an MLS "select" team in 2005 that traveled to face Real Madrid ...

URUGUAYAN WORLD CUP STAR JUAN MANUEL SANABRIA SHINES BRIGHTLY THIS SUMMER ::

First-year Real Salt Lake MF **Juan Manuel Sanabria** (nicknamed "JuanMa") emerged as one of few standouts for his home nation of Uruguay in this summer's 2026 FIFA World Cup, *La Celeste* failing to emerge from group play following its final group stage 1-0 loss to eventual champion Spain ... Sanabria and Uruguay needed the full three points against Lamine Yamal and Spain to advance to the Round of 32 following a disappointing 2-2 draw with surprising upstarts Cape Verde and a comeback 1-1 draw to open the group stage against Saudi Arabia ...



Before starting against both Cape Verde and Spain, the left-sided RSL man entered at halftime for his World Cup debut in the opening match against the Saudis, playing the final 45 minutes and helping spark the South American side's 81st-minute equalizer ... Sanabria started and played the full 90 minutes against Cape Verde in the second Uruguayan match, then again being selected to start against Spain – where his assignment was to contain the blazing speed and dynamic skill of Yamal ...

Sanabria not only endured the test against the incredible Spanish teen, but made a name for himself with his trademark poise and intelligent play ... While Spain dominated possession against Uruguay – as it typically does against any opponent – Sanabria minimized Yamal's effect ... On multiple occasions it was Sanabria who either won the ball when on an island with Yamal, or spearheaded Uruguay's swarming defense in and around the box, denying several chances prior to fruition ...

Ultimately, it was a 42nd-minute gaffe by the Uruguay goalkeeper that saw a weak shot glance off his hands and into the net for a 1-0 Spain lead at halftime ...

Sanabria was removed in the 70th minute as Uruguay opted to push for the two goals needed to ensure advancement, with Yamal subbing out shortly thereafter. Sanabria won 7 of 9 duels, committed one foul (for which he did receive a caution), made seven tackles, three clearances and one interception ...

Popular social media memes alluded to Yamal being one of the items Sanabria removed from his pockets, along with keys, phone, wallet, etc., following the contest ...

In late May, famed Uruguay manager Marco Bielsa named Sanabria – the dynamic, 26-year-old playmaker to the legendary squad ... Sanabria continues RSL's quadrennial World Cup participation tradition, following in the footsteps of **Bryan Oviedo** (Costa Rica, 2022), **Carlos Salcedo** (Mexico, 2018), **Kyle Beckerman** & **Nick Rimando** (USA, 2014), **Robbie Findley** (USA, 2010), **Eddie Pope** (USA, 2006) and **Douglas Sequeira** (Costa Rica, 2006) ...

Sanabria – who leads RSL with six assists in 11 games played so far in RSL's 2026 MLS campaign – departed in late May from Minnesota to Uruguay's training camp in its Montevideo home ... Uruguay returned home after the 17th-ranked FIFA nation – which won the World Cup in 1930 as host nation and the 1950 tournament in Brazil – became the highest-ranked side eliminated at the group stage in the 48-team tournament ...

Arriving at RSL in late January, Sanabria joined the Claret-and-Cobalt via permanent transfer for the 2026 and 2027-28 Major League Soccer seasons from Liga MX upstart Atlético San Luis, with a Club option for the 2028-29 campaign. Sanabria – a dual-national Uruguayan/Spanish citizen – also started and played the full 90 minutes against RSL in last year's Leagues Cup group stage match at America First Field, won by San Luis via shootout tiebreaker ...

Born on March 29, 2000, the dynamic, chance-creating, left-sided Sanabria had appeared in 170 games across all competitions for Liga MX side Atlético San Luis since the summer of 2021, scoring eight goals while playing multiple positions front-to-back on the left side ... In the six months prior to his RSL arrival, Sanabria was a perennial starter and often-times Captain for San Luis, scoring two goals and adding five assists in 22 games across multiple competitions, including the August Leagues Cup matches against MLS sides ...

The Uruguayan international made his professional move to Mexico in mid-2021, arriving from Spain, where he appeared in 46 games across two years. Sanabria scored once in his 13 matches with Real Zaragoza while on loan from Atlético Madrid, for whom he appeared just once as a 19-year-old, mostly featuring with that club's youth side, Madrileño (three goals in 32 matches) ...

The former Uruguay youth international appeared in 88 youth national team games for the CONMEBOL nation's Olympic-age, U20, U17 and U15 selections, prior to his now eight recent appearances in seven invitations to the first team throughout late-stage World Cup Qualifying and the last three FIFA windows ... In June, 2025, Sanabria received his first call-up to Uruguay's senior national team, making his debut last October in a 1-0 friendly win against the Dominican Republic. Sanabria then scored his first goal three days later, on October 13, 2025, in a 2–1 win over Uzbekistan ...

This March, Sanabria was on the field as a substitute for Uruguay's late equalizer in a 1-1 draw at historic Wembley Stadium in London against host England, also coming off the bench late a few days later in Naples, Italy, in a 0-0 draw with Algeria ...

FIRST SUMMER DEPTH MOVE SEES RSL ADD M/F SABA LOBJANIDZE ::

Back on July 1, Real Salt Lake acquired M/F **Saba Lobjanidze** from Atlanta United FC for the remainder of the 2026 Major League Soccer regular season ... The transaction also includes Atlanta's third-round pick



in the 2028 MLS SuperDraft, with RSL sending \$625,000 in General Allocation Money (GAM) to Atlanta, which would receive an additional \$100,000 in 2027 GAM if Lobjanidze re-signs with the Claret-and-Cobalt ...

Born on December 18, 1994 in Tbilisi, Georgia, shortly after the dissolution of the former Soviet Union, Lobjanidze – a current U.S. green card holder, qualifying as a domestic player for MLS roster purposes – arrived in the North American top-flight in August, 2023, signing with Atlanta, where he recorded 15 goals and added 21 assists in 93 career appearances for United ...

Prior to his RSL arrival, Saba owned two goals and one assist in 13 appearances with Atlanta, the 15th-placed Eastern Conference side ...

“This addition of Saba to our roster should provide depth at multiple positions and competition in training each day,” said RSL’s Chief Soccer Officer and Sporting Director **Kurt Schmid**, noting that Lobjanidze arrives at RSL with a significantly reduced budget charge for the remainder of the 2026 season. “With nearly 100 games played in MLS during the last three years, we expect Saba to adjust quickly to our system, which we think accentuates his attacking strengths and puts him in a position to succeed. We look forward to integrating him quickly as we prepare for our upcoming Burnley FC friendly and our Leagues Cup matches, in addition to the remaining 20 MLS regular-season matches this season.”

Coming to North America from Turkish SüperLig side Hatayspor in summer 2023, Lobjanidze (**FULL PRONUNCIATION: SAH-bah Lobe-jah-NEET-zay**) made an immediate impact, starting six of his nine appearances and notching three goals and four assists in 467 minutes during the regular season, including a goal in his MLS debut on Aug. 26, coming off the bench in a 4-0 win against Nashville ...

Lobjanidze made his first MLS start on Sept. 2 against FC Dallas in 2-2 draw, later recording two assists in Atlanta’s 5-2 win against Inter Miami ... In the MLS Cup Playoffs, the winger made three appearances (two starts) and added an assist in Game Two of Atlanta’s Round One series against Columbus ...

Lobjanidze’s first full season in MLS saw him enjoy a breakout campaign in 2024 for Atlanta, scoring 10 goals in MLS, nine of which came in the regular season ... The Georgian international added seven assists to give him a single-season career-high 17 goal contributions in the League in his first full season, also tallying another goal in Leagues Cup action ...

Lobjanidze also represented his native Georgia at Euro 2024 in the country’s first major international competition, making one appearance in the group stage ... In 2025, Lobjanidze tied for the Atlanta team lead in both assists (seven) and appearances (33) during the regular season, again adding a goal and an assist in Leagues Cup competition ...

Now 31-years-old, Lobjanidze brings a wealth of professional experience to Real Salt Lake. Since turning professional in the 2014-15 season as a teenager, Lobjanidze boasted 288 total appearances, 69 goals and 57 assists across all club competitions prior to his MLS arrival three years and 93 games ago ...

The Tbilisi native began his professional career coming through the ranks of his hometown club Dinamo Tbilisi, making his first division debut on Aug. 10, 2014 for Dinamo in a 2-0 victory ... His first goal came in his first start in a 6-0 victory over Shukura. Dinamo won two trophies that season, the Georgian Cup and SuperCup, while Lobjanidze would add the Georgian league title to his resume the following season ...

During three seasons in his native country, he made 60 total appearances with 12 goals and 14 assists, before making a move to Denmark with Randers FC in the summer of 2017 ... In his first full season in the Danish Superliga, the Georgian winger played a pivotal role in helping Randers avoid relegation ... After scoring three goals during the regular season, Lobjanidze turned it on in the relegation playoff, scoring six goals in six matches to keep his side in the top flight, going on to start all 38 of his appearances the following season across all competitions ... In his final season in Denmark, Lobjanidze scored nine goals and added three assists in only 16 matches before being transferred to Ankaragücü in the Turkish SüperLig ...

The Tbilisi native became a main fixture for his side instantly, starting 45 of 53 matches in his two seasons with the club before signing with Hatayspor in the summer of 2021 after Ankaragücü suffered relegation ... Lobjanidze scored eight goals and added eight assists in his first Süper Lig season with Hatayspor in 2021-22 ... He began last season with Hatayspor, making 21 appearances in league play before an earthquake forced the club to withdraw from competition ... Lobjanidze spent the rest of the year on loan at Karagümrük, contributing two goals and two assists as the team finished in seventh place ...

Internationally, Lobjanidze has earned 43 caps for Georgia, scoring four goals ... Saba made his national team debut on Jan. 23, 2017, scoring in a friendly against Uzbekistan ... He was selected to the Euro 2024 squad and made one appearance in the group stage ... He has experience playing in World Cup and



UEFA Euro Qualifiers, as well as UEFA Nations League with his country ...

GOZO CONTINUES HOT STREAK, MLS HISTORY TERMINATED ::

Prior to his August 12 transfer to Crystal Palace, RSL Academy homegrown and Utah native **Zavier Gozo** had been sensational this season, with six goals and four assists through 16 matches in 2026, although the early May Dallas performance was perhaps his most muted of the year ...

Five of Gozo's 11 goal contributions were of the game-winning variety (two GWG, three GWA), the most in Major League Soccer by a teenager this season ... Gozo's five game-winning goal contributions are not just the most in MLS this year, but tied for the second-most in the League's 31-year history, despite just playing 13 games in 2026 ...

In 2013, Diego Fagundez tallied eight GWCs in 31 games for the New England Revolution, while Gozo is now the fifth teenager in MLS history to notch five combined game-winning goals/assists, joining Fagundez and Freddy Adu (2005), Jozy Altidore (2007) and Alphonso Davies (2018) ...

ROAD IMPROVEMENT NEEDED FOR 2026 BOUNCEBACK ::

The recent loss at Houston and late July setbacks at LAFC and Portland ahead of the early August 1-1 draw at St. Louis dropped RSL to 1-8-3 (W-L-T) away from home this season, including the Colorado loss two Saturdays ago ...

On March 22 at San Diego, the evolving, new-look RSL once again displayed its trademark "xDAWG" resilience in avoiding road losses, as RSL did again this week at St. Louis ...

Despite scoring first at San Diego on March 22, RSL was able to secure a point with the late **Victor Olatunji** equalizer, on the heels of several opportunities for **Diego Luna**, **Zavier Gozo** and **Morgan Guilavogui** that narrowly missed in RSL's comeback attempt ...

Back on March 7, RSL put together an 18-minute, 3-goal burst late in the first half that saw **Sergi Solans** provide his debut goal, **Aiden Hezarkhani** score his second consecutive MLS goal and then a **Zavier Gozo** lefty bombazo to win its first road match in its second attempt of the year ...

In its opening away match this season, RSL dropped the Feb. 21 match at Vancouver in a contest that saw

a late first-half goal disallowed and a retroactive red card to Sabbi ignored by VAR that could have seen RSL up a man for 40 minutes in a 0-0 contest ...

Winning away on just three road occasions a year ago, RSL's 2026 side looks to recapture its Club-best road form achieved during the 2023/24 seasons, when the 2023 side posted an impressive 11W-8L-5T away mark across all competitions, a record which includes that year's Open Cup and Audi MLS Cup Playoff eliminations at Houston ...

In 2024, the Claret-and-Cobalt registered the second-most road points in RSL history, with a 5W-4L-8T MLS reg. season mark, one which does NOT include its heartbreaking, multi-goal Leagues Cup elimination loss to the Dynamo ...

EARLY-SEASON FIRSTS FOR RSL ::

During the first 17 MLS matchdays of 2026, RSL had seen 23 different players start a match, with 2024 MLS SuperDraft pick **Lineker Rodrigues dos Santos** making his first 2026 start August 1 in St. Louis after his season debut off the bench in late May at Minnesota ... MF **Stijn Spierings** and his March 14 heroics adding his name to a now 242-player list that saw yet another RSL Academy product – MF **Griffin Dillon** – appearing for the final 45 minutes of the 3-2 road win at Atlanta on March 7 ...

Newly-acquired Designated Player **Morgan Guilavogui** joined Uruguayan World Cup hopeful wingback **Juan Manuel Sanabria** and veteran DF **Lukas Engel** in making their RSL debuts in the 2-1 win over Seattle on Feb. 28, with the trio of RSL Academy men MF **Luca Moisa** and MF **Zach Booth** joining rookie FW **Sergi Solans** in donning the Claret-and-Cobalt crest for the first time in the Feb. 21 opening-day loss at Vancouver ...

Six weeks ago at Portland, RSL saw first-year U22 DF **Juan Jose Arias** return from injury to make his 2026 debut, which could be critical with centerbacks **Philip Quinton** (calf) and **Lukas Engel** (hip) going down in warmups in recent weeks, and veteran **Justen Glad** (adductor) coming out early in the 61st minute on May 2 against the Timbers ...

Also, prior to the Arias debut, newcomer M/F **Saba Lobjanidze** did become the 237th all-time RSL player to log official minutes, the eighth to register an assist in his Club debut and 14th ever to provide a goal contribution in his initial RSL appearance ...



FIRST FULL YEAR UNDER MILLER FAMILY AUSPICES ::

The complete Utah Soccer family – comprised of Real Salt Lake (MLS), Utah Royals FC (NWSL), Real Monarchs (MLS NEXT Pro), and the trio of RSL Academy teams (U15, U16, U18), as well as facilities in Sandy, Utah (America First Field) and Herriman, Utah (Zions Bank Training Campus) – now enter the 2026 campaigns as the first full years under the vision, guidance and ownership of the Miller family and The Larry H. Miller Companies, including Miller Sports + Entertainment (MS+E) ...

Late last year, Club Governor **Steve Miller** and LHMCO CEO **Steve Starks** installed former RSL player / captain / coach / director **Jason Kreis** as the Club's first-ever President of Soccer Operations, with Kreis charged with evolving the Club's culture, developing elite protocols and procedures in support of the athletes, while managing all aspects of the sporting infrastructure for all teams, with the goals of consistently competing for championships, developing players and staff at every stage of their careers, and deepening the Utah Soccer roots in the Club's community ...

ON-FIELD INVESTMENT YIELDS SEVERAL NEW 2026 ARRIVALS ::

Early on in this first full year of Miller ownership has seen RSL's Chief Soccer Officer and Sporting Director **Kurt Schmid** direct the recruitment efforts to upgrade the first-team roster, as no fewer than five new acquisitions are expected to start regularly throughout 2026 ...

Headlining the quintet is Guinean International and Designated Player **Morgan Guilavogui**, a 27-year-old attacker who arrives from RC Lens (French Ligue 1) after previously starring in the German Bundesliga (St. Pauli FC) and the French Ligue 2 (Toulon FC) ...

During a flurry of early February transactions, RSL added Guilavogui along with a Colombian centerback, **Juan Jose Arias**, who will occupy the fourth and final U22 roster slot for RSL, as well as veteran Liga MX wingback **Juan Manuel Sanabria**, the former Captain for San Luis and a Uruguayan World Cup hopeful this summer ...

Rounding out the list of 2026 newcomers is veteran Dutch holding MF **Stijn Spierings** from Brøndby IF (Denmark), versatile Danish DF **Lukas Engel** from English Championship side Middlesbrough (who played 41 games on loan at FC Cincinnati last year in MLS action) and the NCAA's third-overall scorer, FW

Sergi Solans, an RSL SuperDraft pick in Dec. 2024 from Oregon State, who played last season at UCLA ...

CELEBRATORY GOAL EXPLOSION APRIL 18 v SAN DIEGO ::

RSL – which has scored two or more goals in nine of its previous 14 contests prior to the World Cup break since the Matchday One shutout suffered at Vancouver – secured multi-goal wins in each of its two games prior to the April 22 Miami loss, downing visiting San Diego back on April 18 by a 4-2 scoreline that saw **Diego Luna** and **Sergi Solans** score 90 seconds apart within the game's first six minutes ...

The early goal explosion was just the second time in Club history that RSL scored twice within the first 6 minutes of a match, a feat first accomplished last April in an eventual 2-3 loss against visiting Vancouver, a game that saw **Zavier Gozo** score his first-ever MLS goal in the game's first minute ...

RSL saw rookie Solans strike again in the 38th minute and DP FW **Morgan Guilavogui** score his first-ever MLS goal in first-half stoppage for a 4-1 halftime lead in a first-half performance so fun and dominant that RSL boss **Pablo Mastroeni** said he “only had to be a fan, not a coach, in the first 45” in his post-game press conference ...

RSL last scored four goals in a first half on June 1, 2024, in a 5-1 win over Austin FC; a month later, RSL found the back of the net four times in the second half of a 5-2 win that July ...

That April 18 victory extended RSL's home win streak to six games dating back to last fall, while the standing-room-only crowd at America First Field in last weekend's Rocky Mountain Cup tilt marked consecutive sellout No. 13 ...

The April 22 Miami match saw the venue's fourth-highest crowd ever of 21,512, coming 298 fans shy of the venue record of 21,810 that saw Gareth Bale lead LAFC into Sandy back in 2023 ...

DYNAMIC HOME DOMINANCE AGAINST KANSAS CITY ::

Back in that 3-1 home win over KC on April 4, Luna and Guilavogui pulled the strings on an RSL attack that saw rookie striker **Sergi Solans** hit the crossbar twice amongst several near-miss chances ...

Early in the second half, Solans atoned for being snuffed in a one-v-one with the KC 'keeper by putting



RSL up 2-0, a sequence that saw Guilavogui sublimely back-heel to **Zavier Gozo** at midfield, with the 19-year-old Utah native slaloming into the box before setting up Solans, who cut back from his left to score his third goal in a four-game span ...

In the 82nd minute, Gozo himself provided the highlight-reel goal of the year so far, taking a pass from **Noel Caliskan** on the right wing, his first touch popping up and forcing a cross-body volley into the far side of the goal, unknowingly creating the 2008 MLS Goal of the Year from former RSL man Will Johnson in the second-ever match played at the former Rio Tinto Stadium ...

For his efforts, Gozo won the MLS Matchday 6 Goal of the Week, by popular fan vote, amidst speculation he could be a late addition to this summer's U.S. World Cup squad, should Pochettino look to take a flyer on the young, prescient winger for his 26-player roster to be unveiled on May 26 in New York ...

EARLY-SEASON REMATCH WITH SAN DIEGO FC ::

Back on March 22 at San Diego, RSL earned a late 2-2 draw with the second-year Southern California team, as Nigerian striker **Victor Olatunji's** 85th-minute equalizer rescued a late point for the Claret-and-Cobalt, in a match that also saw RSL rookie **Sergi Solans** score his second of three goals already this year ...

Just as in 2025, RSL and San Diego enjoy an early-year home-and-home series ... A year ago, San Diego won 3-1 on Utah soil in its first-ever visit to the Beehive State, with RSL returning the favor by an identical 3-1 scoreline away in its first trip to Snapdragon ...

LATE DRAMA RESCUES RSL IN HOME COMEBACK v AUSTIN ::

In what was perhaps a foreboding for Olatunji's late heroics at San Diego on March 22 was RSL's come-from-behind win at America First Field a week earlier, when Dutch DF **Stein Spierings** came off the bench to provide the game-winning goal in the 88th minute – just seven minutes into his RSL career – to become the sixth debutant out of 235 in the Club's 22-year history to score in his Claret-and-Cobalt debut, and the first to do so as a substitute ...

Spierings' goal – the Matchday 4 MLS Goal of the Week winner – broke a 1-1 deadlock that had featured both goalkeepers – **Rafa Cabral** for RSL and Brad Stuver for Austin – trade exquisite, highlight-reel saves, with RSL rebounding from an 18th-minute set piece concession to Jon Bell to equalize when a **Noel**

Caliskan cross in the box was deflected into Austin's own goal ...

The composed, come-from-behind win in RSL's last home game matched RSL's total from 2025, when only one of its 13 wins across all competitions arrived when NOT scoring first ...

THIRD TIME A CHARM IN ATLANTA VICTORY ::

In an 18-minute span at Atlanta on March 7, RSL saw rookie striker **Sergi Solans** and two of its 18-year-old Academy Homegrowns find the back of the net, with playmaker **Aiden Hezarkhani** scoring for the second time in as many weeks and breakout winger **Zavier Gozo** providing what would prove to be the game-winner ...

While making his first-ever RSL / MLS start, French-born Guilavogui assisted on Solans' first-ever professional goal, while Solans then set up the Hezarkhani blast that put RSL up 2-0 midway through the first half ... Centerbacks **Justen Glad** and **Philip Quinton** were credited with assists on the lefty Gozo cutback that snuck just inside the far post that gave RSL the 3-1 halftime lead, an MLS "Goal of the Matchday" nominee ...

That day's third-ever Atlanta visit, on Matchday 3 of the 2026 MLS season, in the third month of the 2026 calendar, served as the charm, with RSL winning at ATL for the first time ever ...

RSL last visited Atlanta in 2022, dropping a 2-1 decision in what was then 18-year-old MF **Diego Luna's** first-ever start for the Club; RSL also lost in its only previous visit (2-0, 2018) ...

UPWARD TRAJECTORY STAGGERED IN 2025 ::

Mastroeni has publicly stated that this season's roster is the most talented he has seen in his five years in Utah ...

During each of Pablo's previous three full seasons at the RSL helm prior to last year, the Club increased its annual point total (47 in 2022, 50 in 2023 and 59 in 2024), while increasing its Western Conference table position as well (7th in 2022, 5th in 2023 and 3rd in 2024) ...

While the 2025 campaign featured RSL securing its Conference-best fifth consecutive postseason berth, its seventh in the last eight seasons and its 15th in the last 18 years, the Club did suffer its most losses since 2006, and its fewest goals scored since 2015 ...



The 2024 MLS regular season reached an all-time high of 59 points for RSL, which finished third in the Western Conference and sixth overall in the then-29-team MLS Shield race, while also establishing a new all-time scoring high of 65 goals ...

The 3-1 victory at San Diego on April 26 of last year also marked Head Coach **Pablo Mastroeni's** 100th career coaching win across all competitions for the two Rocky Mountain Cup competitors, RSL (2021-present) and Colorado (2014-17) ... The former U.S. World Cup stalwart has now amassed 117 wins, 127 losses and 81 draws across all competitions for the Utah/Denver-based sides ...

Since his August, 2021 arrival in Utah, Mastroeni's all-time coaching record is now 85-78-50 (W-L-T) ...

HOMEGROWN HYPE TRAIN PICKING UP STEAM ::

In each of the first few matchdays, RSL saw six RSL Academy Homegrown players start for the Claret-and-Cobalt, including regulars DF **Justen Glad** and FW **Zavier Gozo**, along with MF **Aiden Hezarkhani**, MF **Luca Moisa**, MF **Griffin Dillon** and Utah-born MF **Zach Booth** ... Three of the players – Gozo (19), Hezarkhani (18) and Moisa (17) – were 18 years old or younger (Gozo celebrating his 19th birthday on March 22 at San Diego), while Booth and Gozo are born-and-raised Utah natives, with Dillon raised locally ...

Joining Moisa and Booth in making his Club and League debut Feb. 21 at Vancouver was rookie FW **Sergi Solans**, a former UCLA/Oregon State product ...

FW ARI PIOL UNDERGOES SUCCESSFUL ACHILLES SURGERY ::

Nearly 3 months ago, RSL FW **Ari Piol** underwent successful surgery to repair his ruptured left Achilles tendon, an injury suffered in the 82nd minute of the Feb. 28 2-1 win over Seattle ...

Piol – who scored the eventual game-winning goal in the 47th minute against Seattle – also saw an apparent goal disallowed in Matchday 1 at Vancouver ... The Seattle game-winner was the Australian U22's second-ever MLS goal and his first since March 8, 2025, in a 3-1 win at San Diego ...

Piol is expected to miss the remainder of the 2026 season, but pledged to come back stronger and better than ever:

"Football can be beautiful and brutal at the same time. It's hard to accept, but I believe there's purpose in

every setback," posted Piol on [Instagram](#). "Appreciate all the love. See you next season. Stronger!"

IRON MAN RAFAEL CABRAL CRITICAL CAPTAIN FOR RSL ::

"Iron Man" GK **Rafael Cabral** – a 2025 newcomer to Utah, after 462 professional games played with some of the world's biggest clubs in his native Brazil, England and Italy – last year emerged as RSL's Captain and leader, wearing the armband for the last 46 consecutive games since Emeka Eneli's May 24 injury ...

Cabral was the lone player to start each of RSL's 40 games across multiple competitions a year ago, playing each and every one of the previous 3,600 minutes of the campaign, highlighted by his historic penalty-kick shootout performance in July against Club América ...

Cabral matched the most minutes ever played in an MLS reg. season by an RSL player (3,060, Zac MacMath, 2022) and established a new all competitions minutes record for RSL's 21-year history (3,600 including Champions Cup, Leagues Cup and MLS Cup Playoffs) ...

In RSL's penultimate regular-season match last year at Seattle, Cabral saved his fourth regulation penalty kick faced in eight attempts last year, denying Jordan Morris from the spot ...

This season, Cabral had played every minute of the Club's 22 MLS reg. season and 5 international matches, including Leagues Cup, aside from the August 22 bench appearance in Orlando ...

PERENNIAL POSTSEASON CONTENDER ::

With another 2026 postseason berth this November, RSL would extend its West-best active playoff streak to six consecutive seasons (Orlando enters 2026 with six straight in the East), the Claret-and-Cobalt having advanced to the postseason in seven of the last eight seasons (2020 the lone exception) and 15 of the last 18 years, its near-perennial placement missing out only in the 2017 and 2020 campaigns since first advancing in 2008 ...

RSL boss **Pablo Mastroeni** became just the sixth head coach amongst 205+ in all-time MLS annals to have taken his team to the playoffs in each of his first five seasons with a Club, elite company indeed ...



However, since a 2021 run to the West Final in Portland, RSL has suffered elimination in its first postseason step each of the last four seasons ...

Mastroeni welcomes two new coaches to his bench in 2026, with third-year assistant **Anthony Pulis** elevated and **Jamal Campbell-Ryce** (Real Monarchs assistant, 2024/25; former EPL / EFL player) and **Fredric Brilliant** (former NYCFC player, former Utah Royals FC assistant) joining RSL ... GK Coach **Mirza Harambasic** remains on staff along with lead Video Analyst **Rob Rogers**, the group looking to attain the heights of 2024, when RSL delivered its Club-best campaign of 59 points from 34 games and 65 goals scored ...

IDEAL RSL STARTING XI AMONGST DEEP 2026 ROSTER ::

While injuries and sales have not allowed RSL's ideal 2026 Starting XI to appear this season, along with visa issues, green card approvals and more, here is what many predicted as the Claret-and-Cobalt's first-choice XI, lining up in a new-look 3-5-2 / 3-2-4-1, as HC **Pablo Mastroeni** now asks his side to defend and attack in a similar setup, a departure from the last two seasons:

NINE PLAYERS SELECTED FOR MARCH INTERNATIONAL DUTY ::

The RSL pipeline saw nine members of the Club's developmental pathway represent their respective countries throughout the March FIFA international window ...

Headlining the March international class is Uruguayan World Cup hopeful **Juan Manuel Sanabria** ... The winger with the nickname "JuanMa" will help lead *La Celeste* as it participates in two European-based friendlies, first at 'The Home of Football,' London's legendary Wembley Stadium, as Uruguay faced England on Friday, March 27, prior to closing camp against Algeria on Tuesday, March 31, in Naples, Italy ...

Appearing in the Club's last four unbeaten matches after being acquired by RSL late in the 2026 offseason via transfer from Liga MX side Atlético San Luis, Sanabria has integrated into the squad quickly, logging four consecutive starts after missing the season opener, notching one assist in the Claret-and-Cobalt's 2-1 home win on Feb. 28 over Seattle Sounders FC and adding another on March 22 at San Diego ...

19-year-old RSL homegrown **Zavier Gozo** was slated to travel to Cheonan, South Korea with the United States Youth National Team U21 squad to take on the hosts in a pair of friendlies on March 28 and March 31, but elected to stay in Utah ... Gozo has been a mainstay with Real Salt Lake after breaking onto the scene with his first start against San Diego FC on Apr. 26, 2025, a 3-1 win ... Since then, the Utah native has started in 29 of his 30 last appearances across all



competitions, a streak only trailing RSL ironman **Rafa Cabral (33)** and **Justen Glad (30)** and tied with MF **Noel Caliskan ...**

The 2026 leading scorer for RSL is none other than another 18-year-old Academy sensation, **Aiden Hezarkhani**, who was supposed to book his ticket to Alicante, Spain, as a member of United States Youth National Team U19s prior to his groin injury suffered at San Diego ... As part of the week-long camp, the States took on a pair of European sides, first facing Wales on March 28 and an opponent TBD on March 31 ...

Hezarkhani has started every match for 3W-1L-0T Real Salt Lake thus far, filling in for USA superstar **Diego Luna**, who missed the first three matches of the 2026 campaign due to a minor knee injury ... Making the most of his sudden opportunity, Hezarkhani logged back-to-back matches with goals on Feb. 28 at home against Seattle and on March 7 at Atlanta to spark RSL's four-match unbeaten streak ...

Trinidadian DF **Kobi Henry** – who was originally scheduled to make a full return from injury to help his Caribbean nation face Venezuela on March 27 in its lone friendly of the window – has now been moved to questionable status after an adductor injury in a training session two Wednesdays ago ... Making his senior team debut for the *SocaWarriors* on Sept. 5, 2025, against Curacao, Henry started and played the full 90 minutes in each of his six international contests against fellow CONCACAF nations, scoring twice – his debut goal coming in his third-ever game, a 3-0 win over Bermuda, also finding the back of the net in a 2-2 draw on Nov. 16, once again versus Bermuda ...

The RSL first team-contracted duo composed of wunderkind **Luca Moisa** and **Gio Villa** were called into coach Jeremy Hall's United States Youth National Team U18 roster to compete in the 29th annual Lisbon International Tournament ... The Stars and Stripes taking on Iceland on March 26, Morocco on March 28, and Portugal on March 31 ...

Taking advantage of visa delays and injuries throughout the RSL midfield this year was Academy product Moisa, who broke into the starting XI late in the Claret-and-Cobalt's preseason ... Moisa logged three consecutive starts to kick off the 2026 campaign, notching an assist in his first MLS home match, a 2-1 win over Seattle on Feb. 28 ... Villa has played a big role in the MLS NEXT Pro Real Monarchs' unbeaten start to the year, logging two full 90-minute shifts in 2-2 (4:3) and 5-0 results over North Texas SC and Sporting KC II ...

Rounding out the MLS-contracted Utah-based players appearing for Club-and-Country is Academy product

and Monarchs standout FW **Antonio Riquelme**, representing Chile and participating in two U20 friendlies against Peru ... *La Roja* faced off against its COMNEBOL rival on March 29 and March 31 ...

Riquelme has enjoyed a hot start to the 2026 campaign, appearing in all four Monarchs matches, scoring three times while logging 275 minutes, tied with **Marcos Zambrano** and **Lineker Rodrigues** for the early-season Golden Boot lead ...

Monarchs Captain **Gio Calderón** reported to Puerto Rico Men's National Team camp this window, the centerback leading *El Huracán Azul* as it hosts Guam on March 25. This is Calderón's first call up this calendar year, last appearing on October 13, an international friendly against Argentina at Soldier Field in Chicago ...

RSL Academy U18 Goalkeeper **Konstantinos Kyriazis** participated in the second round of the UEFA European U17 championship, representing Greece, which will open the tournament facing off against the hosts Montenegro on March 25, prior to facing Sweden on March 28 and closing against Norway on March 31 ... Kyriazis has received back-to-back call-ups this calendar year ...

RSL YOUTH MOVEMENT CONTINUES INTO SECOND DECADE ::

Now entering the third full season of the Club's "Winning Together Through Development" era, RSL's 2026 roster also features Utah homegrown attacker **Zavier Gozo**, who burst onto the scene last year with 20+ consecutive MLS starts en route to a star turn for the U.S. in the FIFA U20 World Youth Championships in Chile ...

A native of Eagle Mountain, Utah, after being born in SLC suburb West Valley City, then-18-year-old Gozo scored his debut MLS goal just days after his high school graduation last May ...

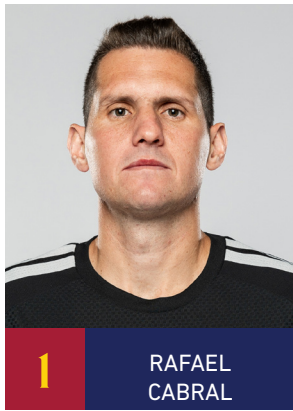
